## *2026 Penn Relays Preview*

130<sup>th</sup> Edition--April 23-25

Franklin Field-Philadelphia,PA

This is an abridged version of my annual Penn Relays Preview. Time constraints kept me from providing previews of the field events (except for the Olympic Development Men's and Women's High Jump/Triple Jump).

The lineups listed for the college races are based on the entries sent in by coaches earlier this month. Some changes are likely. The times listed for each runner reflect 2026 bests or best estimates.

**Once again, the longer college relays (4x8, 4x1500/mile, DMR) are loaded, with Collegiate Records possible in all 6 races.**

The times listed for Jamaican high schools aren't necessarily their best of the season, but they give a good indication of their potential.
