An Offer You Can't Refuse!

As noted on p. 256 of the previous edition of *Track Newsletter*, '02 will see us jumping into the brave new world of an e-mail version. And why is it an offer you can't refuse? The answer to that question is threefold:

- You'll get more—way more—issues.
 - You'll get the material significantly faster.
 - You'll pay less for the whole package.
- Told you you couldn't refuse!

"What's the catch?" you ask? There isn't one, really. It's just the miracle of modern electronics going to go to work for you. No more waiting while we send pages out to be printed; no more waiting while we stuff the pages into envelopes and postage them; most of all, no waiting while the U.S. Snail sends the material on its merry way through sleet, snow & hail.

There has been one change in the plan since we first broached it to you in the last issue. That's where we said that we'd be producing *TN* as PDF files that you'd have to download with Acrobat Reader. We've decided that's too complicated a step, so we'll simply be providing the material as part of a general e-mail. The trade-off is that you're going to lose the formatting (things like proper fractions, bold-facing, and larger-type headlines) you get in the print version. We feel it's worth it in terms of the time and aggravation it will save you in accessing the material.

This year you paid \$50 (\$75 for international subscribers) for 18 issues: in '02 the e-mail rate will be just \$40—any city from Aachen to Zyyi—and you'll get 40 (that's right, *forty*) issues. That's 2 issues in January, then weekly through August, then 3 issues in September, 2 issues in October and November and 1 in December. The issues will be e-mailed by the Wednesday of each week (earlier if possible). Just a buck an issue, to any known address in the universe... well, at least this solar system!

Don't Have e-mail Capacity?

Still want a nicely formatted product for your archives? One that comes mailed flat, printed on both sides, pre-punched, with the smooth typography? We can do that, but here's the other side of the coin. The price for that goes up, and the service gets worse. The word "archive" is key here. This is *TN* as a research tool, not as a source of breaking news.

There will be only 10 print issues of *TN*. The first will be mailed in the middle of February. Then they'll follow at the end of every month March through October, concluding with a final wrap at the end of December. The domestic version will continue as 1st-class mail, international as air-mail.

The print version alone will cost you \$60 (\$85 international). Note that one other advantage of the print version is that since it won't be rushed out the door right after a weekend's action, it will contain more of the things that we have to do research on, like splits, missing wind readings, field-event series, etc., etc.

Go Both Ways
