What Are All Those Symbols?

We realize that there is a lot of material to absorb in our agate (agate is journalese for small type containing the results), so let's see if we can't clarify it a bit for you.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as (x, 5 W), (3, 7 A) or (9, x C) indicates position on the all-time top 10 performer and performances listings.

In the (x, 5 W) example the athlete has a better PR, therefore there is an "x" in the first position. But it's still the No. 5 world performance ever. (W=World; A= American; C= Collegiate; J= Junior)

The (3, 7 A) example means that the person moves to No. 3 on the all-time U.S. performers list, with the No. 7 performance. And (9, x C) means the athlete becomes the No. 9 collegian ever, but the performance is outside the top 10.

Yearly list leaders are given for the world (WL), U.S. (AL) and NCAA Div. I colleges (CL), and sometimes for high school (HSL).
