The U.S. total of 25 overall medals represents a significant improvement, bettering the hauls from Sydney (20) and Atlanta (23). The American men garnered 19 medals, with over half of those, 10, gold. Only 6 of the U.S.'s 13 men's medals in '00 were of the gold variety.

The U.S. women definitely were hurt by Marion Jones's drop in output, taking just 6 medals, 2 gold, this time, after 4 golds and 7 total medals in Sydney.

ATTENDANCE

No figures—official or unofficial—were ever released. Stadium capacity was c72,000. Most evening sessions were close to sold out; most morning sessions were perhaps half full.

Estimates for those sitting on the grass in Olympia ranged from 15,000 to 20,000.

WEATHER

Official temperature—both C and F—and humidity readings are given with each event (finals only).

EXPLAINING THE TYPOGRAPHY

Paragraph breaks in the preliminary rounds of running events indicate the separation between qualifiers and non-qualifiers.

COLOR CODING

All medalists appear in red ink; all Americans who didn't win medals appear in blue ink (if in multiple rounds, only in the final round in which they competed); field-event top finishers appear in green ink in the by-round charts; multi-event leaders are also green in the by-event charting.

FIELD CHARTS

In the by-round field charts (all throws, horizontal jumps), the athlete's best of the day is underlined. The asterisked marks represent the progression of the lead. This includes those with subsequent drug DQs, since the intent is to demonstrate how the event played out in its proper historical perspective.

WHAT'S IN VERSION 2?

The alterations made between Versions 1 and 2 of this newsletter include no official changes in the results. Primarily—as a result of post-Athens video investigations—you will find more splits and many modified splits. (Eventually we hope to have fully auto splits for all legs of the 4x4x, not just the last two legs.) Some errors in statistical ponderings have also been corrected.

Version 2 of the men's events is as of October 13, 2004. Version 2 of the women (eTN 34) will follow.
