INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA, JUNE 21–24*(Junior Champs held in conjunction beginning on June 20)*

Meet held at Michael A. Carroll Stadium on IUPUI's 8-lane (9 on the straightaway and 200) Mondo Super X track; walks held at 06:30 a.m.; multis began in morning; for rest of events a late-afternoon/early-evening meet.

Attendance:

6/21—5480; 6/22—8525; 6/23—7719; 6/24—7407 (total 29,131) (6/20 was 4409 for total-total of 33,540). Last year's total here was 30,050.

Who's Going To Osaka?

The USATF protocol for figuring who will actually make the World Championships team is, to say the least, difficult to understand in places, given new rules put in place to meet the IAAF's changed stance on A and B qualifiers.

There has been no official word yet, so we will here give you a *rough* guide as to what we think is up. We believe that all the athletes we have in red are "guaranteed" spots in Osaka. We believe that the athletes in blue are in line for a spot, but marks made between now and August 1 (the USATF deadline) could change their status.

There *might* also be people not marked in blue who are still in line to chase positions on the team. But we think we're pretty close!

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as (x, 5 W), (3, 7 A) or (9, x C) indicates the athlete's position on the all-time top 10 performer and performances listings.

In the (x, 5 W) example the athlete has a better PR, therefore there is an "x" in the first position. But it's still the No. 5 world performance ever. (W=World; A= American; C= Collegiate; J=Junior; NCAA=NCAA Championships).

The (3, 7 A) example means that the person moves to No. 3 on the all-time U.S. performers list, with the No. 7 performance. And (9, x C) means the athlete becomes the No. 9 collegian ever, but the performance is outside the top 10. Marks making top 10s are bold-faced. Any records are both bold-faced and printed in red.

We also note yearly leaders for the world (WL) & U.S. (AL).

All wind readings are in meters per second, and any positive reading over 2.0 (4.47mph) is illegal ("w").
