

### — Geb's WR Attempt Yields No. 2 Marathon Ever —

Dubai, United Arab Emirates, January 18—Haile Gebrselassie traveled to the Standard Chartered Dubai Marathon to take a

passed halfway in 61:27.

He slowed after 30K but revived enough (2:52 last kilo) to record the No. 2 all-time performance, just 27 seconds slower than the WR and an equal amount short of the million dollars on offer for a record in the race.

## eTN Q&A: Alan Webb On An 8/15 Double

T&FN's *Sieg Lindstrom checked in with Alan Webb to ask the mile American Record holder about his plans for the Olympic year:*

**T&FN:** *You had a fantastic '07, with the only missing puzzle piece a medal at the World Champs. Will you follow the same training blueprint for '08 or make changes?*

**Webb:** I guess the only thing we're changing a little bit is because I'm really happy with the way my 800 developed last year. I feel like I'm definitely on the right track when it comes to that, so maybe pushing myself in the other direction a little bit. I feel like I can bring out that 800 side of me a little bit more easily because I developed faster than I expected to last year. So now I don't have to really focus on it as much as I probably would during the early stuff this year.

**T&FN:** *Is that double possible at the Trials?*

**Webb:** The double... I mean, is it possible-possible? It's possible but it's kind of insane, is what it is. Oh, man. Six races? It's like, 'Oh gosh!'

The 8 is first and then the 15 is second. The 15 is at the end of the week. It kind of stinks because I'd rather have it the other way; the 15 is priority No. 1 and then be able to do something extra if I wanted to. But we'll see.

**T&FN:** *You were so close to a medal in Osaka: 0.92 seconds behind gold and just 0.65 behind silver. Is there any tweak you might make in preparation this season with that in mind?*

**Webb:** Like I said before, each system is a different beast. If, for example, I decided to be crazy and double at the Trials that would change things. If I only did one event and I went in the 1500, that would affect it. How I choose to race before then would affect it, and what I choose to do before would depend a lot on how I feel and how I'm training. So it's kind of hard to give a concrete answer.

**T&FN:** *This will also be hard to answer concretely, but since you've mentioned that a Trials double is possible, what are the chances that you actually would double?*

**Webb:** Maybe not 50/50; maybe 1 out of 3.

**T&FN:** *What kind of season do you have planned indoors?*

**Webb:** I have no plans for indoors, actually. I don't think I'm going to do anything. That's the biggest change for this year. I think I'll do zero indoor.

**T&FN:** *And you'll train just as you did last winter?*

**Webb:** For the most part. I won't be racing so I'll get to do a little different stuff in training. That's the biggest difference. For example, the reason I raced so much in '07 was because I needed to. I didn't race at all in '06.

So now in '08, well, what happened in '07? Well, I put in a lot of racing time and I can't race all the time so I need to train. That's it in a nutshell.
