No surprise—the men's shot putters stole the USATF Indoor Championships show.

But—surprise, surprise—it wasn't Adam Nelson launching the big bombshell.

Model of inconsistency Christian Cantwell howitzered out a 70-7 (21.51) in the first round and the event was effectively over.

Nelson was nowhere close to his 73-foot form from nine days earlier in Arkansas and wound up a stunned 3rd at 69-8 $\frac{3}{4}$ (21.25), as Reese Hoffa snared the silver at 70- $\frac{1}{2}$ (21.40) and the other ticket to Valencia.

It will be the third straight Worlds with a Cantwell/Hoffa tandem. They went 1–2 at the '04 Worlds; in '06 Hoffa success Cantwell—who didn't make it out of the qualifying—as the gold medalist.

Nelson continued as the world leader, however and headed to the bank with the \$25,000 Visa Championship Series paycheck, but who knows how this setback will work on his confidence factor heading into the Olympic Trials?

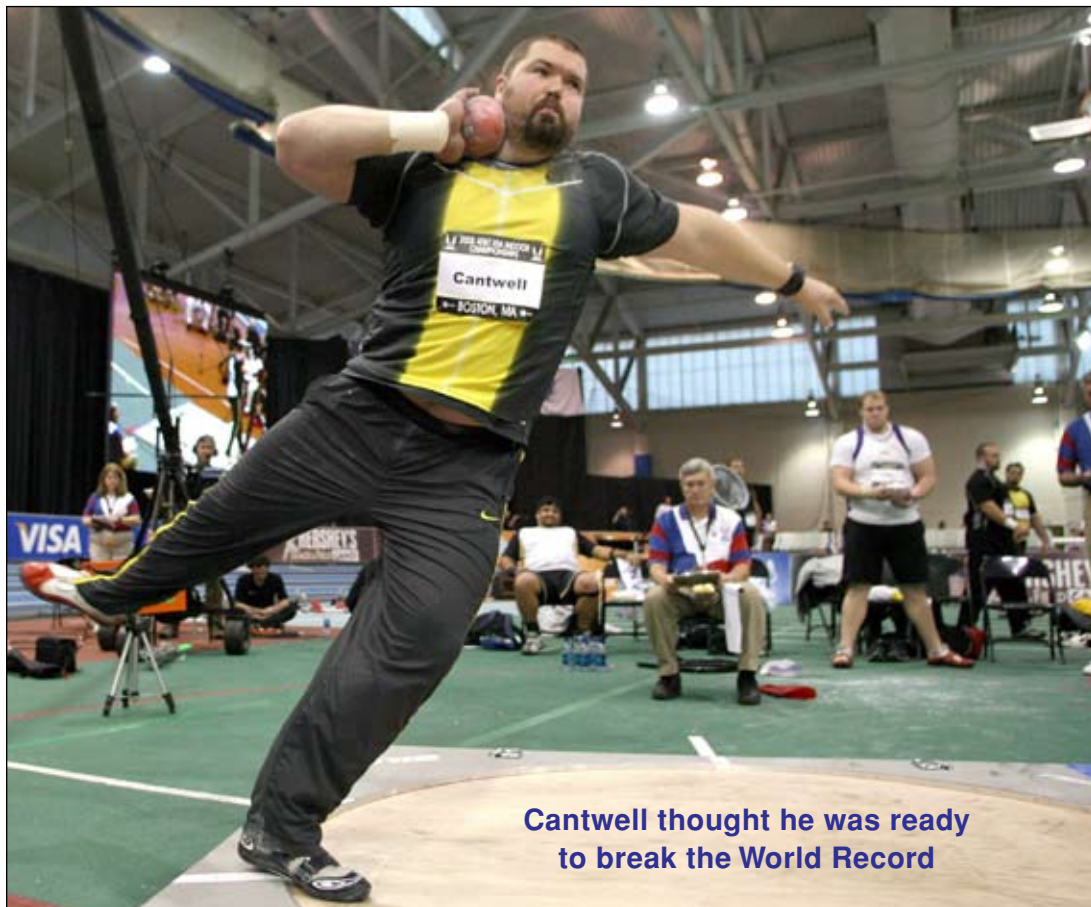
Cantwell—like several others in inhospitable

Boston—struggled through an incredible snowstorm-induced travel ordeal just getting to town, and then was handed the 120mm ball to throw when he prefers the 128mm model.

But even with this shaky grip, he stormed back to the top of the podium and now—maybe, maybe—it's his turn as the event's

Cantwell had good reason to be optimistic, as he had PRed on Thursday as part of an uncommonly consistent series that had found him topping the 70-foot mark on each of his six throws (see p. 37).

"Maybe you can call this a blessing in disguise," said Nelson. "I can forget about indoors and start focusing on the outdoor season and building up to the Trials."

Cantwell was happy with his win, but disappointed with his distance, saying, "I

The USA Indoor Championships needed some sunshine after wintry weather threatened the first day, and the brightest ray came in the form of Lolo Jones, who stormed to the Visa Championship Series title and \$25,000 payday with a 7.88 for her second straight national indoor 60 hurdles crown.

Jones needed to break 8.00 to snatch the big prize away from miler Christin Wurth-Thomas, who the day before had a dominating performance in the 1500.

Wurth-Thomas entered the meet as the leader in the money chase after a PR 4:27.18 mile win at the Tyson Invitational (*eTN* #7), and she did all she could Saturday evening to keep a firm grip on the cash.

A dawdling pace overt her first 400 gave way to a spirited 2:08 final 800 for the former Razorback, who won by more than three seconds in a lifetime best 4:14.21.

Two former prep phenoms hooked up in the 60, with Angela Williams continuing her fine streak of dashing in a 7.11 win over Alexis Joyce, who garnered her first national team spot with a 7.21.

Racing for the first time in 11 months, Shannon Rowbury made a bold move over the final few laps to take the measure of an experienced field in 8:55.19, and in 3rd was another relative unknown in former Rutgers ace Julie Culley.

In a meet with no record-setting efforts, Jenn Stuczynski came the closest in the vault, clearing 15-5 (4.70) before missing thrice at a would-be AR 15-9¾ (4.82).
