## eTN Q&A: Coach John Smith

*In the March issue of T&FN you can read a Preview assessment of the Olympic Trials 400, where Jeremy Wariner and fellow Osaka medalists LaShawn Merritt and Angelo Taylor comprise a formidable trio of favorites.*

*HSI coach John Smith, who guided Steve Lewis and Quincy Watts to Olympic 400 gold, relishes the challenge of respectfully trying to unseat one or all of them.*

*Indiana grad David Neville, one of three young 44-second types now in their first full season with Smith, sounded an early warning of his seriousness when he won the USATF Indoor title last week.*

*T&FN's Sieg Lindstrom spoke with Smith before the indoor nationals about his talented LA-based quartermiler cadre.*

**T&FN:** Tell us about your 400 guys.

**Smith:** [LSU alum] Kelly Willie is performing in there, and I have David Neville and [UCLA alum] Craig Everhart. They have a burning desire to want to be the best.

We talk about Kelly [who earned relay gold in Athens] coming back home to his really natural event, and he's surrounded by two other guys who are hard workers. So it's going to be real interesting to see who's No. 1 out of our camp, and that could catapult them to the awards stand to put on one of the medallions, preferably gold.

**T&FN:** You mention Willie returning to his natural event. Why the decision last year to focus on the short sprints.

**Smith:** Well, because, No. 1, he got to me only around this time of the year, around February, and he really hadn't had the preparation and we just hadn't had time.

So we decided it was best for him to stay with the event he's been running the last couple of years and slowly start moving back to the 400.

**T&FN:** How long has Neville been with you?

**Smith:** This is his first year. He wasn't

with me at all last year except for 6 weeks prior to him going and running 45.24 in the semifinals [at USATF]. But he wasn't fit at all. That just goes to show how really talented that young man is.

He's 6-4, he weighs 163lbs. He reminds me of [88 Olympic medalist] Danny Everett. He's got speed like Danny Everett and it's interesting to watch him run. He's a little longer and a little more fluid.

**T&FN:** What impresses you about your three quartermilers?

**Smith:** I've not been around them when they've been fit, I'm getting to know them this year.

The one thing about Craig is you know he's very talented because of what he has done in his early years, and he's coming back into his old form. So I'm getting a chance to teach him so that he can really understand his race pattern.

David and Kelly are two people that I spend more time watching. There are some things that we all are trying to put together so that by the time I get to the finals I have a good idea of how they will be able to execute. Because one, they are fast. They're two of the fastest guys out there. So now is the time to put that speed there so that you can piece the race together and get a feeling of the race.

That's what we're going through right now. Actually, at this point when you're talking to me, without blowing my horn or anything, we're still on our learning curve together.

**T&FN:** Unlike many quartermilers in an Olympic year, all three are racing indoors.

**Smith:** Absolutely. That gives me an opportunity to be there first-hand, watch them and be able to help them move around.

Now I don't put very much emphasis on indoor because it's very difficult to run fast indoors. But the thing is it gets your competitive juices there, and they're not afraid to run.

**T&FN:** Will they go to the World Indoor should any of them make the team?

**Smith:** When they make the team, they're going. None of them are lacking competitive spirit.
