Sun Devils Score Here Too

Fayetteville, Arkansas, March 14–15—Unlike their men's counterparts, it wasn't all that surprising that Arizona State's women won the NCAA team title. But Greg Kraft's squad did beat the formchart in holding off favored LSU, 51–43. The Sun Devils got a Collegiate Record pentathlon from Jackie Johnson.

Also scoring CRs were Texas 200 runner Bianca Knight (22.40) and Stanford triple jumper Erica McClain (46-7 ¼). Knight's mark was also a World Junior Record, while her 7.16 in the 60 heats rated as an American Junior Record.
