

— Bekele Back On Top At World Cross —

Edinburgh, Scotland; March 30—Kenenisa Bekele proved in front of 18,000 spectators at the 36th IAAF World Cross Country Championships what many of them already suspected, namely that he's the greatest harrier in history.

The 25-year-old Ethiopian bounced back after

However, Bekele had the disconcerting experience of losing a shoe a third of the way into the race, with it dragged off from behind while the leading pack was still 30-strong, and losing nearly 40m.

Tadese, who was beaten to the silver by Komon after a battle over the final 200.

Ethiopia had a clean sweep of the individual titles with Bekele preceded by the Dibaba sisters, Genzebe & Tirunesh, who took the Junior and Senior Women's titles, and Junior Men's winner Ibrahim Jeilan. (The last previous sweep was by

blowing a gasket in the suffocating heat of Mombasa 12 months ago—which ended his winning streak at 5—to become the first man to win 6 world cross titles at the 12K distance.

He can hang his latest gold medal alongside the five he earned with back-to-back triumphs in what used to be called the "short course race" before the 4K sprint was discontinued after '06.

In the end, the multiple world champion and multi-World Record holder on the track made it look easy, surging away from Kenya's Leonard Komon and Eritrea's defending champion Zersenay Tadese with a kilometer to go.

ginning," he reflected. "So I decided to stop and lace it up again.

"I knew it would make the rest of the race tough. After the shoe came off I began to think a great deal about what I had to overcome and I had to focus a great deal on my race. If I had tried immediately to catch up it may have affected the rest of my race but instead I controlled my pace."

Once Bekele had recovered the lost ground on his rivals, the other medalists admitted they mentally threw in the towel long before the finish.

"I knew I wasn't going to win after we had started the last lap [of six]," said bronze medalist

The best U.S. individual performance came from Stanford frosh Alexandra Gits, who finished an outstanding 13th for the best performance by a teenage American woman since Melody Fairchild

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took the bronze in '91. The U.S. Senior Women, lead home by Emily Brown in 18th, packed well to finish 4th and miss out on the podium by just 3 points.

The American men finished 7th, with Jorge Torres the top individual finisher in 19th. The Junior Men finished 6th, passed by high schooler German Fernandez in 25th.

eTrack Q&A: Tyson Gay Looks At Texas Relays Baton Duty

Tyson Gay, '07's double sprint No. 1 World Ranker and T&FN Athlete Of The Year, plans to open his '08 season at the Texas Relays this week-end.

T&FN's Sieg Lindstrom spoke by phone with Gay, who recently traveled from his training base in Florida to Dallas for some work with starts/technique consultant Jon Drummond before he kicks off in Austin. An excerpt:

T&FN: How would you rate your fitness compared to this time last year?

Gay: My fitness level is pretty good. I would say I'm just as good as I was last year; maybe a little bit better in fitness; maybe a little bit. The reason I say that is because I have run some 300s and I ran a little bit faster than I did last year at this time of the year.

I haven't run any open events yet and I kind of always base my season off my first open event, which will be in Jamaica, May the 3rd, if I'm not mistaken.

[Before that] I plan on running some 4x4s. Hopefully, I can get in at least three 4x4s this year and I think that will help my strength level.

That's how I'm kind of going to base my [early] season: off my 4x4 splits. I'm not looking to split 43; it's not my event.

I really believe that if you are a world-class athlete you should be able to step into a 400 and run a decent time. So I'm looking forward to splitting at least 45-low. Hopefully, I've never done it before.

T&FN: Will you run the 4x4 this weekend?

Gay: I'm going to run the 4x1 and hopefully the 4x4 if I get picked up on a team. I don't really have first dibs on a 4x4, but if they have any spots left I'm definitely going to run the 4x4.

T&FN: I have a feeling they might try to fit you into that race. The fans just might want to see what you can do in a 400.
