

— Richards Back Home At Texas Relays —

Austin, April 2–5—Austinites think of themselves as open-minded; willing to try new experiences.

Such was the spirit of the 81st Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays this year, with America's top sprinters getting out of their baton-passing comfort zone: quartermilers trying the 4x1, century specialists on the 4x4, cats running with dogs... anarchy. Really fast anarchy.

First up as USATF's sprint development division brought together many of the nation's leading dashers was Sanya Richards, returning home to anchor the Red 4x1.

Could Richards really hope to beat former Longhorn teammate Marshevet Hooker down the stretch? Well, she certainly could with a 5-meter head start, and a scorching opening curve from Muna Lee and solid legs by Torri Edwards and Carmelita Jeter gave her just that.

Their world-leading 42.25 nicked 0.03 from the meet record.

"It was great," said Richards. "I really love competing in Austin in front of my home crowd. We have a really great relay team, so it was nice to come out on top. One more to go."

On the men's side of the short-relay coin Tyson Gay turned near-disaster into the stuff of legend.

Running what he said was his first relay anchor in seven years, he bobbed the handoff from Mike Rodgers, giving up a precious meter to J.J. Johnson—and then calmly ran him down to give his Blue team a world-leading

38.63–38.79 win.

In the longer races, Richards and former Clyde Hart training mate Jeremy Wariner gave previews of brilliant Beijing moments,

giving their teams easy wins.

The women's Red team's 3:23.49 eclipsed the stadium record set at this meet four years ago by Texas' Collegiate Record 3:23.75—also anchored by Richards.

Sanya's 49.4 had her, now as then, running by herself. "It was exciting," she said. "I love running in Austin. The fans are great and I have been training really hard so it's nice to come out here and have a good showing."

Wariner was similarly lonely, his 43.6 leading the Waco All-Stars to a world-leading 3:00.65 victory.

"My training's going great," said Wariner. "I'm where I want to be right now; actually a little ahead. I opened up with a 44.8 back in February, last weekend at UTA I ran a 20.37, so I'm exactly where I want to be."

Gay, who came into the meet hoping to split a "45-low" (*etrack* No. 18) came close with his 45.8 leadoff, but that was unfortunately wasted as his Blue squad failed to finish.

This year's meet was a triumphant return to glory for a meet that last year was all but cancelled by an ice storm. The sun shone brilliantly not only on multiple world-leading relays but also on the year's fastest 100, a PR 10-flat by LSU's Trinidadian star, Richard Thompson (=No. 8 all-time college).

Teammate Kelly Baptiste took the women's century lead with her PR 11.06 win.

Best on the field was a riveting high jump duel between Andra Manson (7-7¾ before missing at 7-8¾) and Scott Sellers (7-6½).
