

— Hot Prep Distance Running At Arcadia —

Arcadia, California; April 11–12—Once again the distance runners overshadowed the sprinters at the Arcadia Invitational, the nation's premier early-season high school invitational.

Even with Long Beach Poly frosh Akawkaw Ndipagbor highlighting the girls 400, the boys' distance races took center stage.

The best result came from the 5000, a first-time event at the SoCal affair. After many wondered why there was a 5000 in addition to a (shudder) 3200, senior Chris Derrick (Neuqua Valley, Naperville, Illinois) powered through the 12.5 laps with impressive splits that increased as the race grew longer.

He finished his final 8 laps in in 8:49, a time that would have been exceptional in the open metric 2M. His 13:55.96 made him No. 6 on the all-time list and, more importantly, was the best ever in an all-high school race by almost half a minute.

The 8-lapper was another one for the meet's impressive recordbooks. The race started slowly, but with defending champ Luke Puskedra (Judge, Salt Lake City) in the mix, all knew the race would be determined over the final laps. Puskedra finished ahead of New Zealand prep standout Dominic Channon 8:46.60–8:48.00, times worth 8:49.46 and 8:51.07 for 2M.

Favorite Jordan Hasay outdueled Christine Babcock the home stretch to win an exciting girls' 3200, 10:03.07–10:04.03 (10:06.57–10:07.54 equivalents for 2M).

"I'd planned to make a mid-race move,"

Hasay said after her third straight Arcadia win, "but whenever I tried to pass her, she just

eTN Q&A With New 10K Star Lisa Koll Of Iowa State

Lisa Koll set an American CR of 32:11.13 at the Stanford Invitational a week ago. Part of her chat with correspondent Bret Bloomquist:

T&FN: At what point in the race did you realize you were on pace for something special?

Koll: I was trying to be conservative. I didn't want to waste what I had done. But I was feeling so good, so relaxed. With about two miles to go I looked at coach and decided I should go for it.

T&FN: When in your career did you feel you were making the jump from good to elite?

Koll: In my mind, I always was. I really started to hit my stride last year. I qualified for nationals in cross country and my goal was to be an All-American.

That was pretty much the goal for me and I made it, but barely [36th]. That propelled me toward where I wanted to be. Since then I won the Big 12 last year [in the 10K]. That was a stepping stone.

In the past few years there have been quite a few stepping stones. When I ran 15:52 indoors here at Iowa State, that was my first major breakthrough. That's when I realized this was something I was going to do even after college.

Getting 2nd at [indoor] nationals was also a good. That put my name out there. This was irreplaceable. This race was a defining moment.

T&FN: Did it help you running against someone the caliber of Texas Tech's Sally Kipyego?

Koll: Being in competition with someone that good, that competitive, makes you want to be better. You live up to the competition. She's also someone I learned from, someone you can talk to who has her life in perspective.

T&FN: What are your plans for the rest of this year?

Koll: I'm definitely thinking about Beijing. I'd like to qualify an A-standard (31:45). I'm not sure what I'm going to do the rest of outdoors.

I'm definitely going to want to focus on the 10K. Nationals is just two weeks before the Trials and I don't want to be tired. But Nationals at Drake is pretty much like my home track. I'd like to do the 10K. We'll see how the next couple of weeks pan out.
