

— Kastor Claims OT Marathon Crown —

Boston, April 20—Deena Kastor came to Boston as a heavy favorite to win the U.S. Olympic Marathon Trial. That being said, making the team was still not going to be easy, as evidenced by Magdalena Lewy Boulet's bold attempt to distance herself from the field from the onset.

The course started in downtown Boston and consisted of one 8-mile loop followed by three 6-mile circuits that would end at the traditional Boston finish line.

Lewy Boulet, who had shown good early-season track form by running a 32:33.02 at the Stanford Invitational, promptly bolted to the lead.

To her surprise, no one shadowed her and she ran solo in the lead through 5K (18:01), 10K (35:35) and 15K (53:18). The gap at this point between

her and the lead pack was an astonishing 1:28 and had grown to almost 2:00 by the 14-mile mark (see pace chart on the next page).

Kastor, meanwhile, was a bit perplexed. She knew someone had forged a 2:00 lead, but didn't know who it was. The Olympic bronze medalist, however, did not waver from her game plan of running a reasonable early pace before stepping it up over the second half of the race.

She separated herself from the main pack at mile 16 and by 21 had narrowed the gap to 56 seconds. By mile 23, she had almost reeled in the leader and was just 10 seconds back; by

the time she rolled onto Boylston Street for the final time, she was in complete control, and finished 44 seconds ahead of Lewy Boulet's PR 2:30:19 in 2:29:35.

Tucked nicely in 3rd was Blake Russell, who had a comfortable lead over Zoila Gomez and Tera Moody as she crossed the finish line in 2:32:40, erasing all the bad memories of her 4th-place finish in the '04 OT.

The winner admitted, "In the middle miles I thought I might have misjudged Magdalena's strength. I tried to pick up the pace and I kept hearing 'a minute forty [from the crowd]. I tried not to dip anything under 5:20 to 5:25 pace because I wanted to make sure I was staying in the right energy zones.

"The gap started shortening a bit. That fueled my fire and I started to gain confidence

eTN Q&A With Collegiate Javelin Find Corey White

Javelinist Corey White twice PRed at Mt. SAC, first at 257-7 (78.52) on his second throw and then a big 267-10 (81.65) on his final effort. The 6-foot-1, 22-year-old USC junior spoke with Jon Hendershott of T&FN after the competition:

T&FN: You were saving up your efforts for that final throw?

White: Yes, I passed my fourth throw. Then I had my coach Dan Lange and teammates and other throwers clapping me up so I went for it.

T&FN: Did anything tell you that today could be a day like this?

White: With huge competition like this... my coach actually didn't want me to throw at first. Since we have a lot of big meets coming the next few weeks, he didn't want me to throw. But I was pretty adamant because there would be good competition out here.

T&FN: You threw 233-10 [71.27] in '06 at Redlands, then sat out all of last year. Why was that?

White: I had ACL meniscus surgery from playing football at Redlands, so took the year off and transferred to USC. I was a football player who threw the javelin, for sure.

T&FN: What made you get serious about the javelin?

White: After I won some meets [including '05 U.S. Juniors and '06 NCAA III] and realizing I was doing pretty well, I figured it didn't make sense to keep playing football after I got hurt.

T&FN: Was it difficult to sit out all of '07?

White: Yeah, it was horrible to sit out and watch everyone else do well. I'm a competitive guy and I wanted to be a part of it. I just trained all the time with coach Lange. He's had a lot of experience coaching elite athletes, so it was worth it to work with him to improve my technique.

T&FN: What does a throw like this do for you in an Olympic year?

White: Well, 81.65 doesn't do much for me yet. What I wanted was 81.80 [268-4], the Olympic A-standard. That was miles beyond anything I had ever thought of before this year. But now it's a real possibility.

Now I just want to keep doing what I've been doing trainingwise. Coach has a plan for me from here on, ever since I stepped it up a bit in Texas [previous PR 256-10/78.29]. Now I want 81.80 and then go on from there.
