

— 114th Penn Relays —

Philadelphia, April 24–26—Like a house cat batting around a helpless mouse, Leonel Manzano toyed with his rivals at the 114th Penn Relays. For the third year in a row he

Manzano and the rest of Thursday and Friday's competitors benefited from spectacular conditions, with sunny temperatures in the upper 70s. The weather chilled for Saturday's finale, but the meet still drew a near-record 3-day total of 113,302.

In Friday's DMR Manzano blasted a 54.5 last lap to finish up the ho-hum total time of 9:32.89.

Though he was given the lead, the Texas senior had no interest in running solo, and slowed enough to first let Stanford's Russell Brown, then eight other teams, catch up to him.

Villanova's Bobby Curtis looked poised to make a run for the title, but even his 3:59.3 anchor wasn't enough to threaten the 5-foot-5 spark plug, who gave Texas its third straight win.

Saturday's 4xMile was déjà vu. Texas and Michigan had a 15-meter lead on the field as the anchors took the baton. And once again, Manzano was only too happy to run comfortably, allowing most of the field to catch up. Rocketing away with 150 meters to go, he used a 53.7 last lap to give Texas a 16:29.50–16:31.04 win over Virginia.

"With this being my last year, it's kind of nostalgic," he said. "To have competed here for three years and win five times, it's

just tremendous."

Michigan's Nicole Edwards pulled off a similar double, dashing away from Tennessee's Sarah Bowman on the homestretch of both the distance medley and 4x15. In the DMR, the Wolverines clocked 10:49.58, the second-fastest ever, and tantalizingly close to Villanova's 10:48.38 from '88. Tennessee's 10:50.51 was good for No. 4 all-time.

The 4x15 wasn't as statistically impressive, but Edwards once again had her way with Bowman in the stretch run. Bowman had a swift 4:15.2 split, but she'd spent too much energy catching up with Edwards to have much of a kick left.

The Wolverines didn't run the 4x8 but Bowman's homestretch futility continued. She was no match for NCAA indoor 800 champ Latavia Thomas, a Philadelphia native who gave LSU an 8:30.98–8:32.60 win. Thomas also anchored the winning sprint medley and ran a strong third leg on the runner-up 4x4.

"Latavia grew up competing in this meet, and I know it was special for her to come back home and run as well as she did this weekend," said LSU coach Dennis Shaver.

The USA vs. The World series continued into its ninth year and much to the delight of the vocal Jamaican fans, the yellow-and-green scored two big victories, the men's 4x1 (thanks in part to U.S. leadoff Leroy Dixon getting clocked in the face by another team's baton just before the first exchange, meaning anchor Tyson Gay was hopelessly out of it by the time he got the baton) and women's sprint medley.

The U.S. made up for that with big wins in both 4x4s (world-leading times of 2:59.71 and 3:22.16), and a thrilling anchor-leg duel between Allyson Felix and Sanya Richards in the 4x1. Felix came up the winner, 42.57–42.64, but Richards definitely made her case for inclusion in the Beijing short-relay pool.
