Stanford, California, May 4 — Shalane Flanagan's 10K debut at the Payton Jordan Cardinal Invitational ran her into the American Record books again.

The 26-year-old North Carolina alum outsprinted New Zealander Kim Smith in the homestretch to win in an AR 30:34.49 as she lowered the U.S. best from the 30:50.32 set by Deena Kastor in the '02 edition of this meet.

Providence alum Smith chopped her own NR down to 30:35.54, while well-back 3rd-placer Sally Kipyego of Texas Tech lowered her own Collegiate Record to 31:25.45 as the first 10 all got under the Olympic A-standard of 31:45.00.

As usually happens here, breezy late afternoon conditions turned into a calm, ideal distance running atmosphere by the time the featured women's 10K started just after 8:30.

Rabbit Rose Koskei of Kenya went to an immediate lead, trailed by Flanagan and Smith. By 2K (6:04.1), the leading trio was more than 15 meters ahead of the next pack led by Jen Rhines and the leaders were on a projected pace of 30:30.

A succession of 72/73-second laps (see box) carried the front trio past halfway in 15:17.4, well ahead of the 15:27.3 Kastor had produced. Koskei dropped out at 5200 meters and Flanagan and Smith were on their own.

The two traded leading throughout the

second half. The leaders ran as a mirror-image over the last two laps and down the final backstretch. Flanagan pulled even with the Kiwi at about 170 to go and took the lead for good coming off the final turn. Her last lap timed 69.5.

"The plan was to go out conservatively — anywhere from 15:25 to 15:30 — and then cut down," Flanagan said. "I felt good, but I

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also had been warned that all of a sudden [in a 10K] the monkey's going to jump on your back and it's going to be a death march. But I felt controlled the entire way. I felt I was getting fatigued in the final kilometer, so I told himself not to mess it up."

Smith earlier echoed a comment later made by Flanagan: "I couldn't have done it without her."

The usual parade of stellar distance running took place all over Cobb Track. In the men's 5000, world champion Bernard Lagat used a 2:00.4 final 800 and 55.8 last lap to cap a 13:16.29 victory, fastest by an American this year, as Colorado's Brent Vaughn set a big PR with his collegiate-leading 13:18.64 in 2nd.

In the women's steeplechase, last year's NCAA champion Anna Willard produced a U.S.-leading 9:37.73 ahead of Lindsay Anderson's 9:41.41.

At 5000, Minnesota grad Emily Brown got a big PR of 15:19.57 to best former Stanford star Arianna Lambie's eight-plus-second PR of 15:22.51.

Over 1500, San Francisco native Shannon Rowbury cut her career-best by more than 4.0 as she won in an American-leading 4:07.59.

In the men's 10,000 Aussie Craig Mottram used a 59.2 last lap to clock a PR 27:34.48

ahead of steepler Günther Weidlinger's Austrian Record of 27:36.46.

First American Scott Bauhs in 7th clocked a huge PR of 27:48.06 for a U.S. leader and the fastest time ever run by a Div. II performer.

eTN Q&A: Jamie Nieto

High jump veteran Jamie Nieto won the '04 Olympic Trials, then just missed a medal at the Olympics with a PR 7-8 (2.34). The 31-year-old Eastern Michigan grad spoke with Jon Hendershott of T&FN at the Mt. SAC Relays:

T&FN: Has placing 4th in Athens been a source of motivation for you since '04, to try to get on the podium this year?

Nieto: Yes. I'm definitely looking forward to this season. I feel it's going to be a great season. I've just been praying a lot and training very hard. I've actually moved out to Manhattan, Kansas, to work full-time with my coach Cliff Rovelto. That's been going really well for me.

It's definitely a motivation factor, getting 4th and wanting to do better. That's why we're here, to get medals, so that's what I'm going to do.

T&FN: When did you move to Kansas?

Nieto: November of last year. That's pretty much the only thing I've done differently. I'm doing basically the same workouts; it's just a little more focused now. And Cliff's eyes are there every day, which is great.

T&FN: Who else is with the group?

Nieto: We've got some good people. Tom Pappas is there. Gwen Wentland, Beth Castagno, Jim Dilling. Scott Sellers is still in college. There are some good collegians there.

T&FN: It must be great to have other world-class people there.

Nieto: For me, it's been a first to actually be able to train with somebody. So that's been great for me. We all have been pushing each other and we have a good group out there. Everyone is very positive and encouraging. It's been great there.

T&FN: You jumped indoors this winter. Some athletes have barely started competing by mid-April, but is there any concern at all for field eventers who have a long year to anticipate with the Trials, Games and second half of the Golden League going well into September?

Nieto: For me, I try not to change or do anything different. This is the way I've been jumping for years. So I just keep things the same, stay focused and train hard, keep praying and I know things will come together.

Sometimes even when an Olympic year comes around, people want to do different things but I think that's the wrong thing to do. You've got to do what will get you there, go with what you're used to. And that's what I'm doing.
