

— Stuczynski Scares AR At Modesto —

Modesto, California, May 10—With just a single clearance at the California Invitational Relays Jenn Stuczynski claimed the highest outdoor vault in the world this season and she then took three solid shots at her own

American Record.

The 26-year-old New Yorker waited until the other eight vaulters were eliminated before making her first attempt. Mary Vincent ended up 2nd at 14-9 (4.50), with comebacking Stacy Dragila 5th at 14-5¼ (4.40).

Once Vincent missed on her third attempt at 15-1 (4.60), Stuczynski had the crossbar raised to an outdoor world-leading 15-5 (4.70).

April Steiner claimed the outdoor world lead at 15-2¼ (4.63), although WR holder Yelena Isinbayeva owns the overall global highest with her indoor record 16-2¾ (4.95) in February and Stuczynski has an indoor 15-7 (4.75) of her own.

Stuczynski's first shot at 15-5 was a smooth, successful clearance with plenty to spare. So she then asked for the bar to go up to an AR 16-¾ (4.90), three-quarters of an inch (2cm) over the AR she set last year.

As the officials went through the laborious process of certifying the height to be accurate, men's AR holder Jeff Hartwig said, "Jenn made this height in warmups by about four inches. She

aired it out."

On all three of her attempts, Stuczynski got up on top of the bar, but then dragged it off with either her thighs or an arm.

Of having the long waits between jumps for the remeasuring process, Stuczynski said, "It was hot [86] out there. I'm from Rochester; I jumped last week and it was 49 degrees.

"This was my highest opener ever. Usually I open around 4.55 [14-11]. This was pretty high for me to open but I'm jumping pretty good and I have to look at it that way. I'm jumping good and it's really not that high of a bar."

Last year's No. 8 World Ranker assessed her record attempts: "On the first one, I didn't get deep enough into the pad. On the second, I just came up shorter. On the third, I thought I was going to get after it. That one was close, too.

"Actually I was over on all three attempts, but I just couldn't get my settings right on the standards."

In the men's shot, World Indoor champion Christian Cantwell muscled his second throw out to 71-4¾ (21.76), an outdoor world leader. He backed that up with a 70-8½ (21.55) on his third effort.

"My first throw [68-8/20.93] would have been real long but I slipped out of the back of the [plywood] circle and when I got to the middle, it popped straight up," said Cantwell. "I told myself not to push as hard and to keep patient. Then when I got to the middle, just try to knock the hell out of it with my hand and see where it goes."

Sprint star Lauryn Williams made her yearly 100 debut with an 11.18 victory, as Michelle Perry went down with a left hamstring cramp as the pair dueled around 75 meters. Williams returned with a 22.85 half-lap win to cap a nice double.

Stuczynski had three good attempts at 16-¾
