

— Geb Happy In Hengelo 10K Loss —

Hengelo, Holland, May 24—The Olympic year edition of the FBK Games was chock-full of performances that added much intrigue on the road to Beijing.

Heading the list was Haile Gebrselassie's strong 2nd-place showing in the 10,000 that proved the venerable Ethiopian is still a force on the track and gave credence to his decision to forgo the Olympic marathon.

Breezy conditions tempered the usual torrid Hengelo pace and after passing 5K

in 13:31.65, Haile covered the break of fellow Ethiopians Sileshi Sihine and Gebr Gebremariam and Kenyans Eliud Kipchoge and Leonard Komon.

African champ Gebremariam was dropped in the seventh kilometer, and when the pace lagged in the ninth Haile moved to the front acting on his assertion "my goal was to run under 27:00." Sihine scorched a 58.5 closer to take the win in 26:50.53 and Geb managed 59.2 to finish off a 26:51.20 effort – the ninth sub-27:00 clocking of his career.

Haile's finish puts him in good position to make the formidable Ethiopian 10K team that won't be fully sorted out until the special 10K at the Pre Classic featuring Kenenisa Bekele.

"I put up a good time," he said, "but we have to wait and see what happens in two weeks."

Bekele tuned up for Eugene by clocking 12:58.94 in a 5000 that began as a record attempt but soon turned into a solo run in the windy conditions.

Surprisingly, for this distance-famous meet, the most significant performances came when Irving Saladino spanned 28-7³/₄ (8.73) in the long jump and Pamela Jelimo sped a stunning 1:55.76 in the 800.

The 25-year-old Panamanian's huge jump came in the opening round with a 1.2 mps, and was his only legal effort as two scratches and three passes filled out his series.

The world's longest jump since '94 (and more significantly, longest low-altitude mark since the '88 Olympic Trials) the mark moved Saladino up to No. 7 on the all-time list (No. 4 non-altitude).

"I was quite surprised," said Saladino, the reigning world champ. "After I jumped 8.50 [27-10³/₄] it was like a dream, now it is even more amazing

Jelimo crushed the World Record of 1:57.18 set by China's Yuan Wang in '93. The 19-year-old Kenyan is a converted sprinter who took up the 2-lapper this year and promptly won the African Championships last month in 1:58.70.

She Jelimo showcased her sprint gear as she simply scorched the final 300 to take down Janeth Jepkosgei's NR, set last year in Osaka, as well as the Junior standard.

"Next time I think I can go much faster," she said.
