

### — Bolt Stuns With His 9.72 WR Over Gay —

Randalls Island, New York, May 31—New York, New York, it's a wonderful town—to set a world 100 record.

If you can do it here, you can do it anywhere, as Usain Bolt proved by living up to

•And, bottom line, he's no Asafa Powell.

But now it's Powell (who ran 9.74 at Rieti last September) who is No. 2 on the all-time charts and Bolt (who'd stood as the runner-up after his 9.76 in Kingston on May 3) atop the list as the current version of "The world's

Olympic or World Championship gold medal; that he's fully aware that world records are made to be broken, and that it could easily be Gay or Powell or an array of others ready to take him to the cleaners next time out.

Down the line, he's booked for Ostrava and not really sure about his schedule after that.

New York sure has a history of achievements in the 100, meters and yards.

Gothamites had seen Leroy Burrell lower the WR to 9.90 here at the '91 Nationals at the now-raised Downing Stadium, Icahn's predecessor.

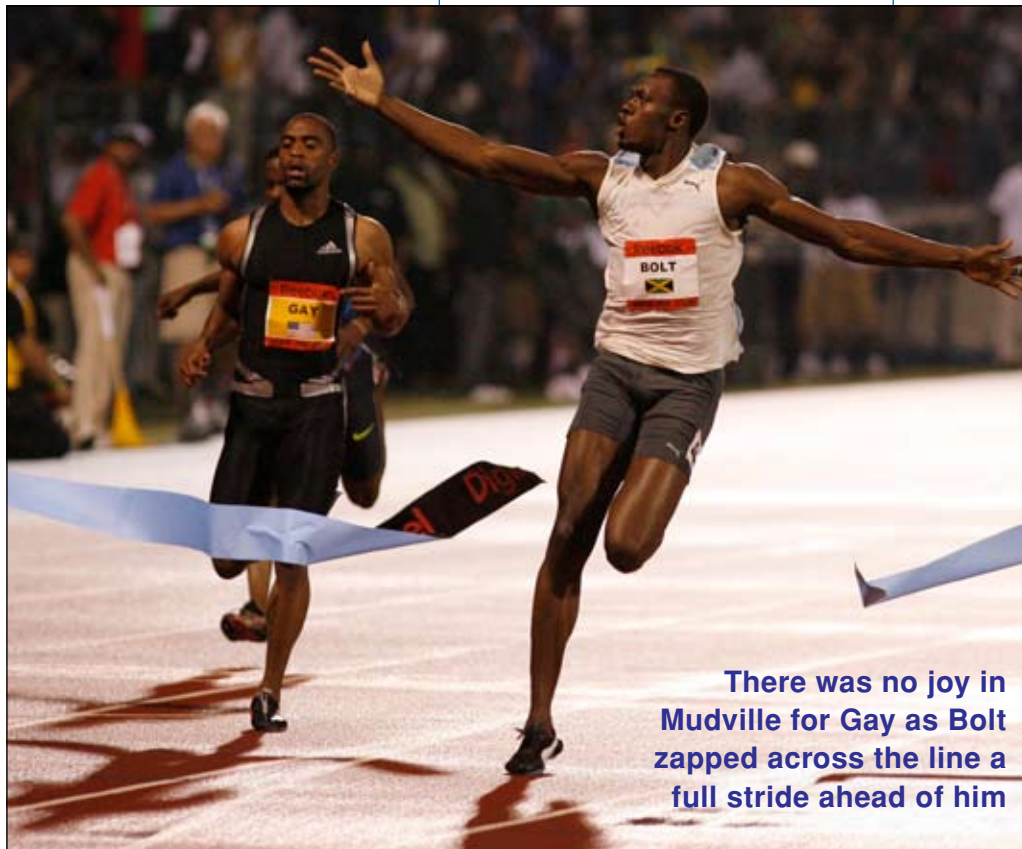
Back at the '61 AAU, Frank Budd cut the world 100-yard mark to 9.2 over the Downing cinders.

Jesse Owens paved the way to his Berlin glories with his 10.4 win at the 1936 Olympic Trials, the first meet ever held on Randalls Island, located just below the Triboro Bridge.

And long-long-long before that, such speedsters as Arthur Duffey, Bernie Wefers, Charles Sherrill, René LaMontagne, William Wilmer and Lon Myers had set world 100-yard marks at various NYC sites.

Reebok Classic fans were also treated to the fastest steeplechase ever run outside of Europe: Paul Koech's

runaway 8:01.85 that left runnerup Steve Slattery (8:28.21) a half-lap back.

the classic Sinatra lyric and delivering a stunning 9.72 to a sellout crowd of 6490 at the Reebok Classic Meet at Icahn Stadium on this small patch of land in the East River.

The critics have been on Bolt's case for years. They've alleged:

•The 21-year-old Jamaican (he'll be 22 on August 21) is too tall 6-5.

•He's too tangled in his own long legs.

•He's still caught up in his Junior-years press clippings.

Fastest Human." (TWFH)

After a single false start, the race went off cleanly and Bolt was ahead the full route. Reigning Osaka triple gold medalist Tyson Gay was a solid but never-threatening second at 9.85 in just the second century of his season, and Darvis Patton's 10.07 and Mike Rodgers' 10.11 leading the rest.

Bolt said all the right things afterwards: that this race won't prove a thing and his career won't be validated until he claims an
