ATTENDANCE

The 91,000-seat National Stadium (the "Bird's Nest") had all tickets sold for all sessions. All evening sessions were "full"; morning sessions were generally about three-quarters full.

WEATHER

Official temperature—both C and F—and humidity readings are given with each event.

EXPLAINING THE TYPOGRAPHY

Paragraph breaks in the preliminary rounds of running events indicate the separation between qualifiers and non-qualifiers.

COLOR CODING

All medalists appear in blue ink; all Americans are in bold face and italics (if in multiple rounds, only in the final round in which they competed); field-event/multi medalists appear in either blue (gold medal), red (silver) or green (bronze) in the progression charts.

SPLIT TIMES

Times in 10ths were mostly taken by the official timer, Omega, by a new system with transponders in the athlete bibs and a wiring system under the track (the *T&FN* split crew also did some video analysis); times in 100ths are eyebeam times from Omega (* for first two legs of 4x4 are start-line times extrapolated for handoffs on 3-turn stagger).

FIELD CHARTS

In the by-round field charts (all throws, horizontal jumps), the athlete's best of the day is underlined. The asterisked marks represent the progression of the lead. This includes those with subsequent drug DQs, since the intent is to demonstrate how the event played out in its proper historical perspective. The top 4 are color-coded.

NOTE THAT THIS IS VERSION ii

There are dozens of changes—most of them small and typographic in nature, but others statistically significant—in this update of the original Olympic results. If you find a discrepancy between the two versions, this one is the one to use. Hopefully we won't need to go as far as Version iii!
