

— Zürich Kicks Off The Stretch Run —

Zürich, Switzerland, August 29 —The 24,000-plus in attendance at Stadion Letzigrund for the second half of the season's first Golden League meet were ready to witness the magic that Usain Bolt and fellow

multi Olympic champ Kenenisa Bekele had displayed in Beijing less than a fortnight ago.

For others, the Weltklasse was a matter of redemption after having experienced disappointment in their Olympic quest for gold.

Coming in, Bolt was not 100%, feeling the effects of a cold, but his racing remained hot. The long-legged Jamaican was in lane 5, with Beijing silver medalist Richard Thompson in 4 and bronze medalist Walter Dix in 60.

his way to a 9.83 victory over Dix (9.99) and Thompson (10.09).

"My start was not too good," Bolt admitted. "I concentrated on winning, and as I'm starting to get a cold I was not able to think about any faster time. My coach told me that I should make sure to end the season healthy."

Bekele proved to be equally untouchable. A gang of four that included Bekele and Ke-

more than 9 seconds ahead of Kipsiro.

Said Bekele, "I was feeling very tired coming here. So I'm very happy to win and run

the fastest time in the world. After my tough programme in China, I could not do any better. I still have one race to go in which I will concentrate on winning and not on the time.”

Those seeking redemption from their Olympic experience included Sanya Richards (400), Jeremy Wariner (400) Blanka Vlašić (HJ)

and Lolo Jones (100H), each of whom won their specialty convincingly while beating the Olympic champion.

Richards started quickly and made up the stagger on Tatyana Firova and was ahead of Beijing silver medalist Shericka Williams at the half way point. She charged onto the homestretch to pull away and finish nearly a second ahead of the Russian in 49.74.

Wariner and gold medalist LaShawn Merritt were dead even at halfway, but then the Olympic runner-up accelerated through the turn and got stronger as the race progressed.

He won by more than half a second and was pleased with the result, 43.82, a season's best. He echoed the sentiment of all when he said it was not revenge for the Olympic Games, but rather “I want to end the season as world No. 1.”

With Merritt having won the year's two biggest races, the OT and OG, that's going to take some doing even though they're now 3-3 in the year's head-to-head meetings.

Lolo Jones took control of the hurdles from the onset, running into a slight headwind. She survived a charge by Spain's early season leader Josephine Onyia and Australian silver medalist Sally McLellan to win in 12.56. Surprise Beijing winner Dawn Harper was a well-back 6th in 12.73.

Paul Koech was the world leader in the steeple going into Beijing, but was left off the Kenyan team after finishing 4th in their trials. He continued his dominance here and won in 8:04.26 over silver medalist Mahiedine Mekhissi-Benabbad of France, who ran a PR 8:08.95 for 2nd.

Although Jamaican Olympic champion Veronica Campbell-Brown was not in the race, Allyson Felix cruised to a 22.37—22.68 victory over fast-starting Lauryn Williams, who was leading after 100 meters.

The two remaining Golden League Jackpot contenders, Vlašić and Pamela Jelimo, continued their winning ways. The Croatian topped the high jump with a 6-8¾ victory over Anna Chicherova and Chaunte Howard, with Olympic champion Tia Hellebaut back in 8th.

Said the winner, “I felt I was physically capable of jumping much higher but I just couldn't find my technique and, for some strange reason, the surface was a little soft for me. I just couldn't get things completely right. However, I was pleased with the competition, coming just a few days after being in Beijing.”

Meanwhile, 18-year-old Kenyan sensation Jelimo won the 800 in 1:54.01, setting yet another World Junior Record (her fifth of the year) in the process and becoming the No. 3 performer of all time.

“I can tell you I am so tired. But this was my best race with the best pacemakers,” she said after Beijing 4th-placer Svetlana Klyuka had dragged the field through a stiff 55.66 first lap before departing, with Jelimo in the lead at 1:25.12 at the 600.

“The World Record is now closer,” said Jelimo, “but I'm not sure I can do it this year; maybe next.”

But the fan favorite was 35-year-old Maria Mutola, who was given a rousing ovation with her introduction and as she departed the Zürich oval for the final time after finishing 4th in 1:58.71.

“There's still one race to go for the jackpot,” said Jelimo, as she and Vlašić still have Brussels remaining next Friday.
