

— Radcliffe Back On The Winning Track —

New York City, November 2—The specter of Beijing disappointment haunted several elite runners in the 39th New York City Marathon, but Paula Radcliffe and Marílson Gomes dos Santos were best able to exorcise those demons.

And Kara Goucher made a historic debut at the 26.2-mile distance, placing 3rd and setting a U.S. record for a first-timer.

Radcliffe had finished 23rd in the Olympic race after a stress fracture curtailed her training earlier in the year. But she came into New York fresh off a British Record at 10 miles a week earlier, and wasted no time asserting herself as the leader.

She started by bucking blustery winds on the Verazzano-Narrows Bridge. The conditions contributed to a 6:31 opening mile, and 5K was passed in just 18:04, but the tenacious Brit was undeterred.

By halfway (1:13:23) she had reducing the lead pack to a single-file line of five pursuers: Goucher, 40-year-old Russian Ludmila Petrova, Ethiopians Geta Wami and Dire Tune, and Kenyan Rita Jeptoo.

Said Goucher, "I do feel a little bad that Paula did so much work, but then she killed us all, so it's OK."

The death blow came from the 19th mile on, when Radcliffe clicked off 5:20, 5:18, 5:12 and 5:15 segments. Her prerace goal

of a negative split was easily achieved, covering the second half in 1:10:23 to finish in 2:23:56.

"I wanted to just keep a controlled temp

able on the favorite's right shoulder though 30K before finally dropping back. She found a second gear in the 21st mile, pulling away from Tune and Wami.

At 35K Petrova started losing contact with Radcliffe and Goucher began to close the gap, trailing by only five seconds at 40K. At that point Goucher had stomach problems and cramping, and could no further gains on the Russian. Petrova (2:25:43) set a new Masters WR, 10 seconds ahead of the Colorado grad.

Goucher's 2:25:53 lopped 65 seconds off Deena Kastor's standard for a U.S. debut (also run in New York, in '01). She also became the first American since Anne Marie Letko '94 to get on the Central Park podium.

The time moved her to No. 3 on the all-time U.S. list, with the No. 7 performance.

Jeptoo (2:27:49) and Catherine Ndereba (2:29:14) followed, while Wami (2:29:25) held on for 6th, ceding the World Marathon Majors title—and \$500,000 paycheck—to Berlin champ Irina Mikitenko.

The men's lead pack (which set off half an hour after the elite women) remained crowded for much of the early going, cruising through halfway in 1:06:06.

U.S. hope Abdi Abdirahman made a few attempts to break away, but once the racing began in earnest he couldn't keep pace. "I ran the way I wanted to run it," he said. "Unfortunately, I got a side stitch from 13 miles through 17 miles. I couldn't run hard again until 18 miles."

Five remained in contention at 30K, when dos Santos and Abderrahim Goumri of Morocco broke free. From mile 20 through 23 Goumri ripped off 4:47, 4:42, 4:43 and

while not taking too much out of me, making sure that I was very comfortable at the half" she said.

Goucher had looked strong and comfort-

4:48 splits and appeared to have the race in hand.

At mile 24 dos Santos was nine seconds back, but the Brazilian, who dropped out of the Olympic race in August, responded with a shocking surge of his own, clocking 4:52 for the 25th mile and 4:47 for the 26th.

He passed Goumri as if he was standing still at about 25½ miles, and hit the tape in 2:08:43, his second half in a swift 1:02:37.

Goumri (2:09:07), clearly dispirited, needed 5:12 for his 26th mile, and was runner-up for the second year in a row. Kenyans Daniel Rono (2:11:22) and Paul Tergat (2:13:10) each ran alone from the 21st mile and held the next spots.

Abdirahman (2:14:17), Josh Rohatinsky (2:14:23), Jason Lehmkuhle (2:14:30) and Bolota Asmerom (2:16:37) went 6-7-8-10, marking the first time since '82 that at least 4 Americans made the Top 10.
