

— Rupp Leads Oregon To Victory At NCAA XC —

Terre Haute, Indiana, November 24—Galen Rupp scored his first individual collegiate crown in leading the Oregon Ducks to a convincing defense of their NCAA Cross Country team title on Indiana State's Lavern Gibson harrier course that has become home for this fall classic. Some 4000 paying customers came out in the low-40s weather to watch the 71st edition of the race.

Once again Rupp was matched in a running duel with an athlete from Liberty. A year ago Rupp came up a second short in a sprint finish with Josh McDougal. This year the Oregon senior sped away from Samuel Chelanga 300 meters from the finish.

Chelanga burst to a 40-meter lead over the opening kilometer, but Rupp closed the gap and pulled even in the fourth K. The duo passed over the halfway mat in a torrid 14:09 then settled in for another sprint match over the final 400-meter finishing straight.

"Sammy looked great with a K to go," Rupp admitted, adding, "I knew I was in for a fight. Last year I went too far out and died. I have been running a lot of mile races and it paid off because it came down to a sprint finish."

Favored Oregon was in full control. Luke Puskedra and Shadrack Kiptoo-Biwott ran at the front of the chase pack, and the 4 other black-shirted Ducks passed by before any other team could count to 5.

Prize frosh Puskedra ran with great composure to finish 5th. Kiptoo-Biwott followed in 9th, with Matthew Centrowitz (45th), Diego Mercado (54th), Kenny Klotz (66th), and 800 Olympian Andrew Wheatling

(75th) completing the team.

Iona stunned the pollsters with assertive running to finish 2nd while Stanford edged Wisconsin for third.

Oklahoma State's bid for a team trophy went amuck when frosh sensation German Fernandez was felled by an Achilles injury at 8K.

The win was Oregon mentor Vin Lananna's fifth NCAA men's harrier title, and first-year hires claimed the other three trophies with Ricardo Santos at Iona, Jason Dunn at Stanford and Mick Byrne at Wisconsin. Complete results follow:

— NCAA Women's Cross Titles To Kipyego & Huskies —

Terre Haute—The women's favorites were tested at the NCAA Championships, but the popular picks still prevailed.

Texas Tech senior Sally Kipyego became the first woman to win three harrier titles and the No. 1-ranked Washington Huskies earned a program-first team crown.

Kipyego, who doesn't have any outdoor track eligibility remaining, outlasted Florida State junior Susan Kuijken on a harsh Indiana day to earn her historic win. The nursing major thus joined men's competitors Gerry Lindgren, Steve Prefontaine, and Kenyan compatriot Henry Rono as the only ones to accomplish the NCAA three-feat.

At 2 miles, Kipyego, who now has 8 NCAA titles combined, opened a 5-meter gap on her Dutch challenger, who finished 3rd a year ago. The gap stayed intriguingly slender until the final kilometer when Kipyego extended the margin to more comfortable proportions. Kipyego's winning 19:28.1 erased her old course record of 19:30.9 set last year.

"It was hard," said the winner. "It was cold and windy and the girls that were running next to me were running hard out there. It was probably the hardest NCAA cross country of all the three. I am just happy to get through and win."

Kuijken held off Virginia Tech's Tasmin Fanning for 3rd 19:35–19:38.

The Huskies of Pac-10 perfect score renown didn't blithely motor through the field as some projected, but still produced the first sub-100 score since Colorado in '04. Though they moved up during the race more slowly than coach Greg Metcalf expected, the Huskies still scored just 79 points to better Oregon, runners-up again, at 131.

A pair of power frosh led the Huskies: Christine Babcock 7th (20:01.7) & Kendra Schaaf (who had skipped the West Regional) 12th (20:17.3). Finishing off the Husky effort were Mel Lawrence 25th (20:32.3), Katie Follett 26th (20:32.5), Amanda Miller 34th (20:37.0), Lauren Saylor 41st (20:43.7) & Anita Campbell 51st (20:50.4).
