

— Hooker Scares Bubka's World Record —

The Millrose Games had a relatively small program of elite competition—just four track events and two events each for men and women. But what the 102nd edition lacked in quantity it surely made up for with enough quality to please the 11,543 Madison Square Garden fans.

Setting the early standard was Aussie vaulter Steve Hooker, who cleared an unexpected PR 19-8½ (6.01) and took three credible attempts at 20-2½ (6.16).

That last would have added half an inch to Sergey Bubka's World Record, which has stood unchallenged since '93.

Hooker, who was coming off a knee injury four weeks ago (the result of a broken-pole accident), had wildly high clearances at earlier heights, then needed three tries at 19-3½ (5.88) to seal the win over Derek Miles (18-8¼).

The Olympic champ flew over 19-8½ to become history's fourth best indoor jumper, and break the U.S. all-comers record. His trio of runs at 20-2½ were promising, coming up just shy of the height needed on the approach.

"It was a little unexpected," the 26-year-old Perth native admitted.

"I've had a really interrupted preparation. I've done one complete pole vault with full approach before I came here. So to come out here and jump a personal best is a bit of a

surprise. And to have such good jumps at the World Record is also quite surprising, but very exciting."

Shortly after the competition, the idea that

being raised half a foot over his brand-new personal best. "My last jump I felt was really, really good," he said. "Probably just need a slightly bigger pole and I'll go close to jump-

ing that, I reckon, with a similar jump."

In the women's vault, Beijing silver medalist Jenn Stuczynski broke her "Millrose curse" (as she called it) and finally won in her fourth appearance at the Garden, at 15-5 ½ (4.71).

She missed three attempts at 15-9¾ (4.82), which would have eclipsed Stacy Dragila's American Record. On her final try the bar bounced off the standards and then briefly settled back into place before falling.

For her part, the injury-plagued Dragila looked strong in finishing second, at 15-1½ (4.61), her highest indoor clearance since she set the AR at the '04 World Indoor Champs.

As is the recent Millrose tradition, the men's shot put was a hyped affair, taking over the infield with decathlon great Dan O'Brien serving as an over-the-top emcee.

In a foul-plagued event the athletes couldn't produce the monster marks of recent years, but there was a dramatic finish.

Christian Cantwell took the lead at 67-4¼ (20.53) on the competition's penultimate throw, only to see Adam Nelson improve the lead to 68-2½ (20.79) on the final heave. That

was well behind his 72-½ (22.07) from last year. "I think this would be called a tactical competition," Nelson good-naturedly told

he had even *attempted* to strike the Ukrainian great from the recordbooks hadn't sunken in. Still, Hooker wasn't overwhelmed by the bar

What If Hooker Had Cleared?

Had the vibrant Aussie been successful at the record height, Steve Hooker also would have claimed the IAAF's "composite" WR from Sergey Bubka.

Because of a stubbornness to go back and recognize older records when the rules change, the IAAF sees Bubka's 20-1¾ (6.14) as the in/out combined WR, while going with his higher 20-2 (6.15) as the indoor-only mark, even though the latter meets the criteria for overall recognition.

Hooker may soon clear up that mess.

Speaking of tactics, Nick Willis demonstrated savvy strategy in the mile—but it still wasn't enough to stop Bernard Lagat.

The reigning world champ won his seventh Millrose mile (and fifth in a row) with a thrilling last lap. After a swiftly rabbit opening 440 (56.9), the pace slowed (1:57.8, 3:00.2) and Lagat lead, comfortably in control. Willis surged into the front with a lap

and a half to go on the 146-meter oval. But Lagat showed fantastic poise in snatching the lead back just before the final curve.

He pulled away for a 3:58.44-3:59.48 victory, matching "Chairman of the Boards" Eamonn Coghlan for most wins in the event. "I had enough reserve in the tank," Lagat said. "I knew [Willis's surge] was going to happen, it was just a matter of if it would be with three laps to go or two laps to go."

Kara Goucher continued her love affair with the Big Apple, defending her Millrose mile title in a PR 4:33.19. "I love New York. It's an amazing city," said the Olympian, who returned there three months after her stellar marathon debut. "The crowds are just so electric. I didn't start racing in New York until last year and I didn't know what I was missing."

As coach Alberto Salazar preps her for the Boston Marathon, Goucher seemed pleased with this result. "This is a good indicator. In an 80-mile week I can still run a 4:33 mile, so apparently he isn't pushing me hard enough," she said with a laugh.

Terrence Trammell bounced back from his disappointing Olympic experience with a blazing 7.45 over the 60 hurdles. About half an hour later he went for a 60/60 double, but three false starts in the dash likely zapped the energy that would have been needed to top Michael Rodgers' PR 6.51. Trammell was in contention until 50, and finished 2nd (6.54).
