Reebok Boston Indoor Games organizers had their domestic stimulus package in place long before Congress.

And theirs had a lot more accountability. "Give us an American Record and we'll give you \$25,000," they told leading candi-

The times, rounded up, will rank them as No. 4 on the all-time indoor charts. Completely obliterated by Flanagan was the American Record of 15:07.44 by Marla Runyan, which had been a virtual solo run at the New York Armory in '01.

"I was surprised," said Flanagan. "But my

bounce. In another smart move, meet organizers had the elevated, Madison Square Garden runway shipped to Boston and installed at the Lewis Center.

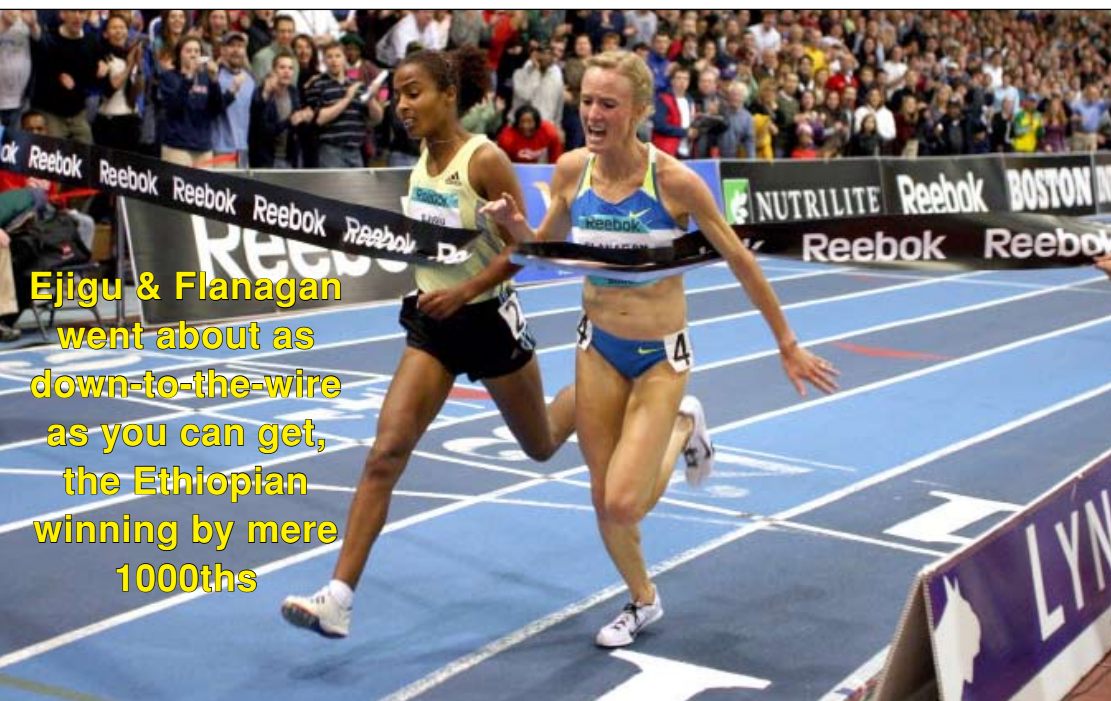
As Stuczynski put it, "having the runway, it brought a different outlook to the Boston Games. I've competed here before and then bringing the runway added a little bit of magic to it. It was nice to be up on that platform. It felt like the pole vault was high-lighted."

Of course, it was high-lighted for Steve Hooker, too. They'd plunked down another \$25,000 stimulus offer for the high-flying Aussie but his was a far tougher deal.

He'd have to soar up and over Sergey Bubka's '93 world record of 20-2 (6.15) to get it.

For the second week in a row, he gave the Ukrainian's mark a scare. After first-attempt warmup clearances at 18-5¼ (5.62) and 19-3¼ (5.87), the standards went to 19-10½ (6.06), which would top the 19-9 (6.02), best-ever-in-America mark by Lawrence Johnson from '01.

dates in the women's pole vault and 5000.

Given the harsh economic climate, Jenn Stuczynski and Shalane Flanagan came to Beantown and leaped at the opportunity. They cashed in, in a big way, at the 14<sup>th</sup> edition of the meet, as a Reggie Lewis Center capacity crowd of 4265 cheered on.

First, Flanagan wrote out her deposit slip with a 14:47.62 clocking. Fortunately, there was nothing in the fine print about actually winning the race. In a sizzling duel with Ethiopia's Sentayehu Ejigu that went down to the final millimeters, Flanagan was edged out by the slimmest of possible margins.

Now that soon-to-be-38 vaulter Stacy Dragila is solidly back on the comeback trail—a most encouraging development for the sport—new champ Stuczynski will be able to have old(er) champ Dragila on hand as an expert witness.

And now Stuczynski was on her own to shoot for Dragila's AR of 15-9¼, set at the '04 World Indoor Championships. Stuczynski made both 14-10 and 15-1¾ (4.62) on her

groove right now, it can easily happen, I just have to get into more meets.”

Meanwhile, back on the track, Lindsay Gallo took the women's mile in 4:27.90, one of six world-leading performances notched in the meet.

Gallo, the former Michigan star, had been a consistent presence on the circuit for years but hadn't crashed through to the winner's circle for nearly 3½ years.

She did it with a devastating lift off the final bend that got her to the wire in front of Mestawot Tadesse (4:28.18) and Sarah Jamieson (4:29.47).

Now based in the D.C. area and training under Matt Centrowitz, Gallo's career is reawakening.

“I'm in shock,” she said, “It feels really good. Coach told me to react and just to stay calm and make a move whenever anyone else did.” She did just that and it paid off.

Millrose mile champion Kara Goucher stepped up to the 3000 and ran down Texas Tech's Sally Kipyego over the final three laps, crossing in 8:46.65. And thus ended her indoor track season.

“From now on, it's marathon-marathon-marathon,” she said. “I go on on a 20-mile training run Sunday morning.”

With her 2:25 debut credentials from New York last November, she will surely be a most watched runner back in Boston April 20.

As for Kipyego, her 8:48.77 gave her another Collegiate Record as she took down Kim Smith's 5-year-old standard.

In the men's 3K, Galen Rupp ran his fastest-ever, indoors or outdoors, but his 7:44.69 sufficed only for 2<sup>nd</sup> back of Ethiopia's Bekana Daba (7:41.88). Still, it did give him possession of the American Collegiate Record, stealing that credential away from Goucher's husband, Adam.
