

### — Rupp Gets AR & CR In Tyson 5000 —

Fayetteville, Arkansas—They don't need to hand out free cowbells to help the crowd get into the annual Tyson Invitational. But they did it anyway, making the crowd of just

at the same time, then a full schedule of the latter on Saturday).

In a competitive 5000 that got the action off to a frenzied start, Galen Rupp continued his hot hand by breaking the American and Collegiate Records at the distance.

But his 13:18.12 was only good for 2<sup>nd</sup> in a talented field, bested by Ethiopia's 20-year-old Bekana Daba (13:17.89), with Liberty's Sam Chelanga 3<sup>rd</sup> at 13:19.79.

Rupp's performance—which has been bettered outdoors by only a trio of collegians—came on the heels of an American CR 3000 last week in Boston, where he also finished 2<sup>nd</sup> to Daba.

"Any time you set a record it's special," Rupp said. "They're all great to me. With about two laps to go I knew about how fast I had to run. I didn't focus on it too long though because I had a race to run."

Former Razorback Seth Summerside set a stable pace at the beginning of the race, which also featured Ethiopia's Markos Geneti.

After a first 400 in 65.2, the group of Summerside, Daba, Rupp, Chelanga and Geneti picked up the pace and distanced themselves from the rest of the field.

At the 2K mark (5:23.35) it became clear to the crowd that Rupp was going to have a shot at beating the AR.

Over the first three kilometers he passed up opportunities to lead and seemed to be happy to let others like Chelanga and Geneti take the reins while he reserved his energy.

When the breakaway posse passed the 3K mark at 8:02.57, Rupp began to show the first signs of exertion as he was comfortably positioned between Daba and Chelanga. Then Geneti surged and took over the lead after Summerside dropped away.

Geneti and Daba would swap leadership of the group for a few laps during the second half of the race, before the group hit 4K at 10:45.08 and Rupp hastened into the lead with two laps to go.

It was a three-man race at that point -- with Rupp having been patient for so many laps it looked like he was destined to perhaps hold off Daba, with Chelanga holding on for 3<sup>rd</sup>. But Rupp was overcome by Daba's speed over the first half of the final lap, and the Oregonian could only find enough answers to preserve the AR, but not to take the race.

"I thought that it might not happen today, but that I just needed to compete hard at the end," Rupp said about the race's final moments. "At that point I just said, 'You've got to turn into a sprinter now,' and just focused on keeping my form. I knew he would kick like crazy, so I was ready for it."

Rupp added that he would take the next week off of racing, and just concentrate on a couple solid weeks of training before getting ready for indoor nationals in a few weeks.

In the theatrical highlight for field events that evening, Adam Nelson led a close shot put event at the final throw. Unfortunately for Nelson that final throw belonged to defending world champ Reese Hoffa, who logged a 69-1¼ (21.06) to snatch the victory in front of a riveted and raucous crowd.

"I hurt my knee in December so I'm still a little behind schedule in terms of how far I'm throwing," said Hoffa, who plans to sit out the rest of indoors to fully recuperate his knee. "I'm starting to get my technique back which is paying off for more distance."

## eTN Q&A: Nick Symmonds

Top-ranked American 800 runner Nick Symmonds, 25, recently spoke with eTN about his running development and his “future” in the mile:

**eTN:** *You ran a 1:53.62 in high school and won quite a few Idaho state titles, right?*

**Symmonds:** I won nine total. As a junior [in '01], I won the 800-1600-3200 and ran on the 4x4. Then I repeated all those my senior year and also got the cross country title.

**eTN:** *You also played hockey?*

**Symmonds:** Yes. I didn't run a step from November 1<sup>st</sup> to about January 31<sup>st</sup>. All I did was skate. In high school, it was the perfect way for me to unwind after a long cross season and still stay in shape.

Hockey was my favorite sport: how fast it is, the team dynamics. I loved ice hockey and, honestly, it was probably the hardest thing for me to give up when I decided to run full-time in college.

**eTN:** *It must get in your blood, like running.*

**Symmonds:** I'll probably take it up again when I'm done running. A rec-league type of thing. I actually got in a pickup game with my dad and some of his friends over Christmas break—and I realized I had lost every single skating muscle I ever had. Turned them all into running muscles. Moving laterally like you have to in hockey was tough.

I was so sore. All my dad's friends are like in their mid-50s and they were outskating me. They were like, “I thought you were an Olympian?” I am—but not in skating.

**eTN:** *When did you get serious about track in general and the 800 in particular?*

**Symmonds:** I'd say that I got serious about running in my frosh year of college [at Willamette]. I was surrounded by people who were so focused and so determined that it just naturally inspired me to be the best runner that I could be.

I went from running about 40 miles a week and running only about six months out of the year in high school, to running seven days a week and close to year-round in college.

College really was both the 800 and 1500, and cross country also. I'd say it was exactly 50/50 between the 8 and 15. I ran them both at [NCAA Div. III] nationals [he won 4 straight 800s '03-06 and 1500s in '03, 05-06].

**eTN:** *When did you decide to emphasize the 800?*

**Symmonds:** Once I got out of college, I sat down with coach [Frank] Gagliano when we began working together and he basically said, “You've got to choose one or the other.” They're so different and you train for them so differently that you can't spread yourself evenly between both. So he asked me what I would like to focus on.

We both decided that I was young and had essentially unlimited potential on the speed side—because I had never done any real speed work.

We decided that the 800 would be the best way to go. And I think we made the right decision. There'll always be room for the 1500 later on.

**eTN:** *A lot of people, media included, will ask about a good 800 guy, “What's his mile potential?”*

**Symmonds:** There are a lot of 800 guys out there who are 400/800 guys; they haven't really gained strength to be a great miler. But the way I train under Gags's system, I'm still putting in 70 miles a week. I'm maintaining the strength side so should I decide to switch to the mile in the future, I'll have that strength. I'll have to develop it a little bit differently than I have for the 800.

**eTN:** *Leave the mile for later, maybe post-2012.*

**Symmonds:** [laughs] There's plenty of time. I can get my mind around 2 laps now; 3¾ for a 1500 is a tough one.
