

— USATF Indoor Championships —

Roxbury Crossing, Massachusetts, February 28 & March 1—Two of the sport's most

ries paychecks and put a positive meet-ending spin on a USATF Indoor Championships that fell far short of many of its predecessors.

Relatively sparse fields in nearly half the events, missing stars, and crowds slenderized by the week-end's snows marked the meet that once was the crown jewel of the whole indoor season and has an often-glorious history dating back to the 1890s.

Even with \$2500, \$1500 and \$500 rewards awaiting the 1–2–3 finishers in every championship event at the Reggie Lewis Center—on top of the \$25,000 bonus to the male and female athletes turning in the top single mark in the four-stage Visa Series—the meet failed to draw many of America's best.

Having no World Indoor Championships to aspire to was part of it, too.

The most notable of the absentees was Shalane Flanagan.

All the local favorite had to do was enter and run in the meet, and regardless of eventual placing would have collected the \$25,000 payoff, based on the 14:47.62 AR 5000 she ran at the Tyson Invitational two weeks ago.

But Flanagan instead opted to run the World's Best 10K Race in Puerto Rico, which offered a \$20,000 winner's prize -

and wound up 4th behind Vivian Cheruyiot, Lornah Kiplagat and Dire Tune in San Juan.

So Jones ran off with the 25 big ones with her 7.84 romp in the 60 hurdles final, get-

ting off to a perfect start and cruising home ahead of Hyleas Fountain (7.98) and Shantia Moore (8.15.) But she couldn't threaten Gail Devers's '03 meet record of 7.74. The 7.84 was worth 10 points fewer than Flanagan's record.

Jones had breezed through an 8.02 heat earlier Sunday, after Saturday's scheduled first round was deemed unnecessary. Then, just 9 ran, from which 8 advanced to the final three hours later.

Jones came to Boston after a great European swing, which saw her run to co-world year list-leading 7.82 victories in Karlsruhe and Birmingham.

Running 10 minutes before Jones's win, Trammell was just as dominant over the men's barrier field. He, too, had a superb start and turned on the afterburners to leave Dexter Faulk (7.53) and Jerome Miller (7.61) in his slipstream. At 7.56, Faulk was speediest out of the heats, which eliminated exactly two men.

The 7.37 was a 2009 world leader, destroying Reggie Torian's meet record 7.38, dating back to '99.

For Jones and Trammell, their victories constituted ritual cleansing of their unfortunate Beijing memories. Jones, of course, crashed into her final barrier of the Olympic final with a clear lead on the pack and wound up 7th. Trammell—who'd earned Olympic silvers in Sydney and Athens—was betrayed by his left hamstring strain and he didn't get beyond the first hurdle in his heat.

"That's behind me now," said Jones, who admitted to having nightmares for months afterward. "I consider it part of my education, a learning experience. I know I'm a real hurdler now, and can run with anybody."

Long therapy sessions and careful training have put Trammell back on the fully-healthy

list. "I had a great start today," he said. "The race was pretty well decided right there."

Before all this, it seemed that the \$25,000 Visa payoff on the women's side would be determined by a careful reading of the fine print in the series regulations.

Amber Campbell had struck the first blow with a huge 20-pound weight heave of 80-2 (24.43), equaling the value of Jenn Stuczynski's AR vault of 15-9¾ (4.82) at this venue three weeks ago.

But, knowing this, Stuczynski fought back by adding a centimeter to her American best with a 15-10 (4.83) clearance. Three misses at 15-11¼ (4.86)—two of them close—ended her day. Then Jones slipped into the top spot with a hurdle mark 2 points better on the IAAF Tables.

The Beijing men's high jump team—Andra Manson (7-7¼/2.31), Jesse Williams

(7-6/2.29) and Dusty Jonas (7-5/2.26) went 1-2-3.

For several more of the Olympic year's frustrated, there was redemption in Boston. Rob Myers took his third 1500 crown by running down Alan Webb, 3:45.73–3:45.82.

Khadevis Robinson proved he could "take it out" and win from the front, too, in a 1:48.61 800.

Dan Taylor (67-9¾/20.67) beat Russ Winger (67-¾/20.44) and Adam Nelson (65-10½/20.08) in a Cantwell/Hoffa-less shot put. On his final effort, Taylor whirled one out that seemed to be at least 72-feet, but couldn't control and stepped over the toeboard.

Trials 4th-placer Brandon Roulhac took the triple jump at 55-7 (16.94), while Randall Flimmons was the surprise LJ winner at 25-6¾ (7.79).

Amy Begley won the Flanagan-less 3000 in 8:53.27.

Tim Seaman made it 11 Nationals victories in the last 12 years with a 19:59.06 in the 5K walk.

Joanne Dow fought off Teresa Vaill for her sixth women's 3K walk crown in 13:04.28. Dow, soon to be 45, had announced her retirement after Beijing, but rescinded that not long after and is back in top form.
