eTN Interview: Arizona State's Greg Kraft

Both Arizona State squads travel to College Station for this weekend's NCAA Indoor as the defending team champions.

Last year, the Sun Devils became only the second Div. I school to win both indoor titles in the same year, following LSU in '04.

ASU head Greg Kraft spoke with eTN after the Mountain Pacific meet about what it's like to be defending two titles:

eTN: Are the double team wins last year's news? How do you prepare teams that are defending NCAA champions for a new season?

Kraft: They are completely different. Starting with the women, they are two-time defending champions. But when you lose athletes like [three-time pentathlon winner and CR holder] Jackie Johnson, [outdoor shot champ and indoor shot-weight double scorer] Jessica Pressley and ['07 outdoor vault winner] April Kubishta, it's significant.

I think the last two years, there were two very good teams in Arizona State and LSU and then there was a pretty wide gap to the rest. This year, I think Texas A&M looks like the favorite and Tennessee and Michigan also look very good. [The *T&FN* formchart gives the nod to the Vols.]

But I don't think any team has the potential to get, say, 60 points. We won with 38 and then last year outdoors we scored 63 and got 2nd to LSU [67]. So every year is different.

For us, I don't think we quite have the quality of depth we have had before, especially in the throws. Sarah Stevens ['07 indoor shot champ] is leading the weight and is No. 2 in the shot. [Sprinter] Charonda Williams is running well. But the 200 can be the luck of the draw; whatever lane you get.

But I've told the women that 40 points just might be the magic number and how we could go about getting that.

eTN: And how about the men?

Kraft: On the guys' side, we took a hit before the season started when we hoped to get [distance runner] Brandon Bethke eligible but couldn't. We've been a little dinged up in the 400 and today we ran 3:08.74. At Nationals, I don't think that's going to get it

done.

But [shot defender] Ryan Whiting has done a great job and [weight thrower] Jason Lewis has come up nicely. But, I don't think anybody thought we would win last year. It was a low score that won last year, but we got to 44 while Florida State was 41.

This year, you look at it and I think it's Oregon's to lose [the *T&FN* chart concurs]. I don't like to put pressure on someone like that, but you look at their roster with the parts they have and they've got to be pro-

year, we had a lot of champions back but for us it worked in our advantage that it was an Olympic year. So for Jackie Johnson and those kids who had a lot of NCAA success... not that it got old for them, but they had to be sharp because their emphasis had changed a little bit.

They had to be sharp collegiately because they knew they had to be ready for the Olympic Trials. So that made our job a lot easier.

So it's a new group, but the thing that's tough for all of us is that our expectation level has changed. I tell the kids there's nothing wrong with being 6th or 7th at the Nationals, but we obviously go in with high expecta-

hibitive favorites. And Florida State is always very, very dangerous.

Our goals every year, regardless, are trying to win our outdoor conference meet at the Pac-10 and be a Top 10 team.

If you have the good fortune to have a roster that can contend for a trophy finish, then you have the chance that things may break right for you.

Last year indoors, it broke right for the men. We didn't have a good meet or a great meet; we had a *perfect* meet and were able to win. It's just fun that people at least have us in the conversation. We used to be under the radar, but now we're definitely on the radar.

But it is a totally different team than we've had in the past few years. Realistically, our men's team may be a year away from truly contending. Our women are pretty shallow right now. We're going to go as far as Sarah and Charonda are able to go.

eTN: As a coach and a staff, do you ever hold up last year's achievements as a goal for the current team? Or is that truly "last year"?

Kraft: Well, every year is different. Last

tions.

Arkansas also will be very tough—but one thing for them is that it won't be a "home" meet for this year. It can be considered that way for A&M. But Arkansas will have that edge outdoors, just like Oregon will next year.

eTN: Do you "worry" about losing the superstars like Johnson and Pressley?

Kraft: Not really. You look at our program and we've always been what we feel is a balanced team. From cross country, to the throws, jumps and sprints.

But what made us a little bit special was that Jackie and Jessica, and Sarah now, were so versatile that they could score a lot of points. Not to take anything away from the rest of the country, but Sarah possibly could win the shot, discus and hammer outdoors. She's that type of athlete.

So if you look at maybe 50–55 points to win and you have one athlete who perhaps can score 30, it makes it easier to try to get 15–20 points out of the rest of the team. But it's going to be fun, regardless.
