RECORDS-RECORDS-RECORDS! The major part of the high school indoor season came to an explosive conclusion on the March 13–15 weekend with the concurrent staging of the two annual “national championship” meets.

As always, the National Scholastic Indoor was held in New York City’s Armory. This year, the Nike Indoor Nationals gained parity on the oval with a move from previous unbanked locations to Boston’s Reggie Lewis Center in Roxbury Crossing.

So both meets were held on notoriously fast banked 200-meter ovals. And it showed.

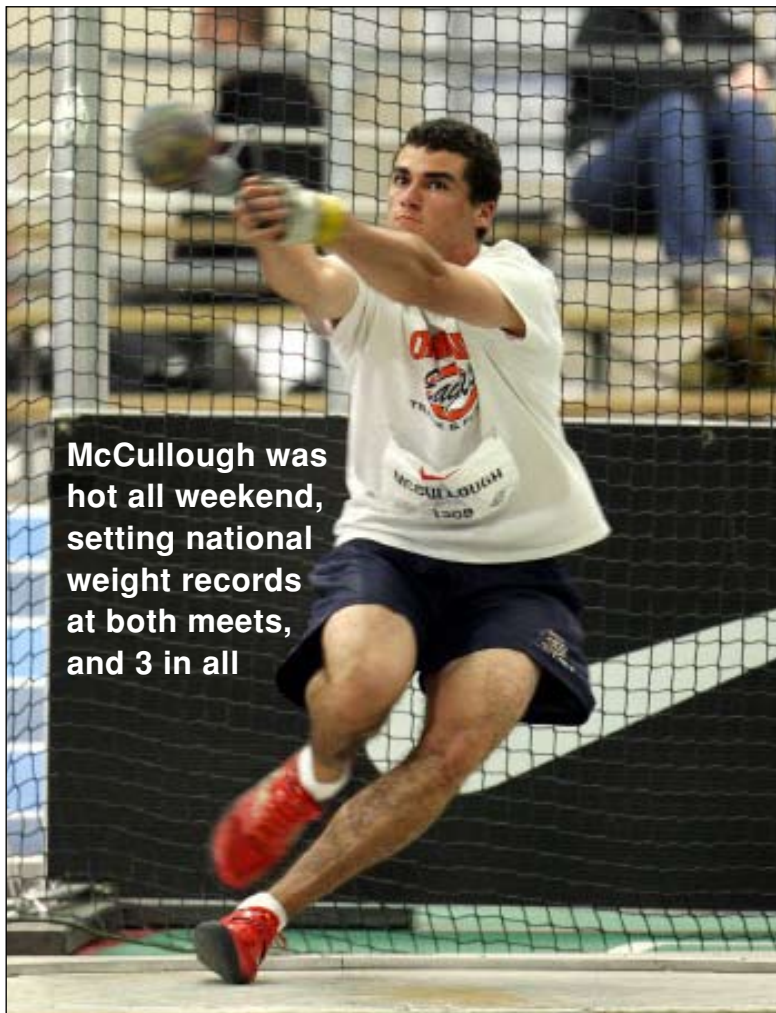
