

— Derrick Beats Fernandez, AJR —

Stanford, California, May 2—Fast 5000s were the order of the evening at the Payton Jordan/Cardinal Invitational. The races came on the kind of calm, windless night that makes Stanford ideal for distance running

and traditionally produces a bucket-load of high-level marks.

Stanford frosh Chris Derrick followed Junior rival German Fernandez for better than half the men's B-race before kicking home to clock an American Junior Record 13:29.98.

It was the first outdoor race of Fernandez's college career and he was known to be shooting for Galen Rupp's 13:37.91 AJR set in '04.

While the Oklahoma State frosh had recuperated in the last month from a sore right foot strained at the Worlds, Derrick had been quietly compiling a fine season, including a PR 13:44.02 indoors and an NCAA Indoor 4th.

The smooth-striding Fernandez moved to 2nd after just two laps and looked full of run.

He took over at 2800 meters and led past 3K in 8:09.6. Derrick moved to the fore at 3600 as Fernandez slipped to 4th.

Evan Jager and Hassan Mead were right behind and with 200 to go, Minnesota soph Mead kicked big to win in 13:28.45 ahead of Jager (13:29.65), Derrick and Fernandez (13:31.78, also below Rupp's former record).

"I expected a fast race and thought I might have a chance at the Junior record," said Illinois native Derrick, who doesn't turn 20 un-

til October of '10. "But the main point was to beat German. I thought it would be a sit-and-kick type of duel.

"Really, I just wanted to get out and run as hard as I could. In the last 800, I knew it would be a matter of whoever was the fastest. I was definitely thinking about German on the last lap."

Derrick admitted, "It means a lot to have broken Galen's record—and it was awesome to do it on my home track. It's a pretty big deal and I'm glad to have it. My coaches [Jason Dunn and David Vidal] and I thought this might be my only shot at the AJR.

"It might be tough to run a fast time at the NCAA. It's all about placing high when you race at the NCAA. And there's a lot of the season left to go." He is thinking of trying the senior men's 5K at USA nationals after the NCAA race.

Derrick placed 15th at World Cross, four spots behind top U.S. finisher Fernandez. "I took time off to recover," Derrick said of his first international experience, "but I knew I still was fit."

Of course, Derrick hopes to run faster and hopefully this year. He added, "But right now, I'm happy with what I've got."

In the very next race, Colorado senior Jenny Barringer front-ran the entire 12½ laps to produce the fastest outdoor collegiate time ever, 15:07.64 (Barringer herself set the CR with her indoor 15:01.70 in February).

Barringer's solo actually followed Derrick's contest and was an everyone-chase-Jenny affair after the first turn. The steeple AR setter simply gave no else the chance to win.

By the time she passed 3000 in 9:07.5, the 22-year-old Olympian had a 120-meter lead over the chase pack. Barringer's 67.0 last lap brought her home a half-lap ahead.

Both 1500s produced American leaders.

Oregon soph Matthew Centrowitz used a 56.4 final lap to move from about 7th with 300 to go to score a PR 3:36.92 win ahead of South African Peter van der Westhuizen (3:37.22) and NCAA Indoor mile champ Lee Emanuel of New Mexico (3:37.25 PR).

Centrowitz barely missed the family record 3:36.70 set by father Matt at the '76 Olympic Trials.

Olympic steepler Anna Wilard showed her own turn of good speed, surging with 200 left to win in 4:06.90, 2.0 ahead of Florida State's NCAA Indoor mile champ Susan Kuijken.

Back in 11th, '08 prep girls AOY Jordan Hasay showed she is gaining fitness after a recent bout of sinusitis. Hasay clocked 4:16.80, the No. 4 high school 1500 in history, and her own second-fastest ever, in her first major outdoor track race since last summer's World Juniors.
