

### — Ducks Claim Collegiate 4xM Record —

Eugene, Oregon; May 9—It was an electric night in Eugene. After weeks of continuously rainy weather people emerged from their homes to sunshine and gathered for the

Unfortunately an AR attempt wouldn't be in the cards because the morning of the race Scott Wall (strained calf) had to be replaced by Kenyan Shadrack Kiptoo-Biwott.

Some 2700 fans—freshly electrified by Jesse Williams' outdoor PR 7-8 (2.34) clearance in the high jump—surrounded the oval in lanes 5 & 6 before the start of the race.

A wave started, circling the track for a couple of minutes and then the Duck and OTC teams came out to the track.

Lananna had wanted this group to “get in position to have fun” and it certainly worked out that way.

“Having the crowd on the track was unbelievable,” said Olympian Andrew Wheat-  
ing.

Rowland was also impressed with the gathering, saying, “The adrenaline with the crowd was absolutely fantastic.”

Frosh Matt Centrowitz (3:59.53) and junior Wheatling (3:59.60) picked off club runners Tom Brooks (4:01.77) and Steven Pifer (4:04.23) with 200 meters to go. Senior

It almost wasn't to be as wavering commitments from other teams threatened to derail attempts at a possible World Record, but more likely American, Collegiate and Hayward Field bests.

Coach Vin Lananna said, “We sent the word out to a lot of schools. Some said yes or no but at the start of the week we said the heck with it and decided to give it a go.”

Forty-eight years ago the first Twilight meet birthed an American Record mile by Dyrol Burleson (3:57.6). The next year Burleson led the Ducks to a 4 x Mile WR of 16:09.0 (actual time 16:08.9) at the West Coast relays in Fresno.

In '68, Eugene was also the site of a 16:05.0 by the Oregon TC that was denied WR status because of team-composition irregularities.

The Oregon time lasted as the American Record until Athletics West ran 16:08.54 at Hayward Field in '84.

With the IAAF no longer recognizing the

Kiptoo-Biwott took off with a 10-meter lead. He opened with a too-quick 58-flat first lap but cooled the next three laps and finished in 4:05.20 in a solo effort.

Luckily senior Galen Rupp had shown his ability to run tough solo efforts to ensure a record performance as Oregon now needed a 4:00.23 to break the CR.

Rupp's 3:58.91 was propelled by an energetic crowd to splits of 57.8, 60.3, 59.8, and 61.0.

"I went out a little too hard," he said. He was confident with 100 to go, explaining, "I just had to run 17 and I knew we would get it."

Said Centrowitz, "We have been talking about this all week. We didn't know when we would get another opportunity."

Lananna—who had gotten what he wanted—high-fived his team and Rowland for his help.

"We try to create something every meet," he said. "There was a lot of hype about the record but the meaning was the hype. The record was nice."

He continued, "This is a special group. There is a collective energy and excitement about them."

As another record had been broken on hallowed Hayward Field another indelible memory was stamped into fan's and athlete's minds. Said an emotional Kiptoo-Biwott, "The memories of this will last a long time."
