

— The Pros Crank It Up In Carson —

Carson, California, May 16—A late-afternoon start on a warm, sunny day combined with a mild ocean breeze made conditions ideal for all runners, jumpers and throwers at

the adidas Track Classic.

The meet began with a solid run by Hazel Clark, as she powered down the home-stretch to take the women's 800 in a meet record 2:01.40, a step ahead of fellow Olym-

pians Jemma Simpson of Great Britain and Christin Wurth-Thomas of the U.S., both of whom clocked 2:01.58.

Next up was a clash between Olympic 400H champions Angelo Taylor ('00 & '08) and Felix Sanchez ('04), and the man who has ranked No. 1 in the world the past two years, Beijing silver medalist Kerron Clement.

The race was fairly even as the athletes approached hurdle No. 7. That was when all kinds of adjustments had to be made as No. 8 was, for whatever reason, 15–20 meters closer than it should have been.

Each lane was equally affected, but the misplacement threw off the steps and strides of all concerned.

Clement went on to win in a world-leading 48.38, followed by Taylor (48.70), who was visibly upset because of the foul-up, and Felix (48.95).

A furious Taylor complained, "Whoever is charge of putting up the hurdles needs to be fired. I came all the way out here and the hurdles are in the wrong spot. I could've stayed home."

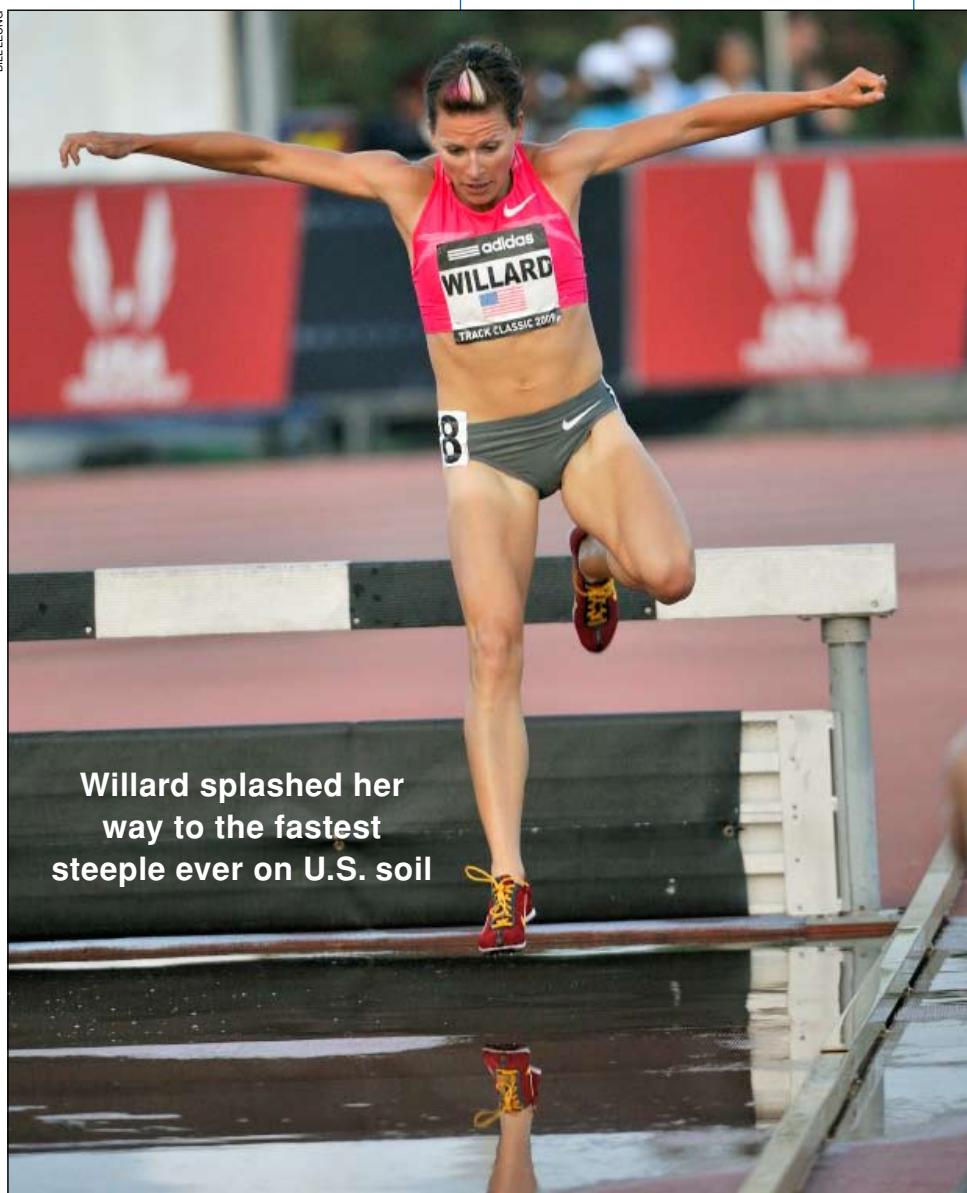
Since conditions were in actuality tougher than the rules lay out, *T&FN* will include the marks on the yearly lists. Given that it's unlikely that everyone was affected in the same way, however (because of differing stride patterns), the race won't count for World Rankings considerations.

Heading for a steeplechase showdown with hot Jenny Barringer, Anna Willard ran away with the event here, lowering her own U.S. all-comer's record from 9:27.59 to 9:26.85, the No. 5 time in American history.

On paper, the best head-to-head matchup was to be between Olympic teammates Allyson Felix and Sonya Richards in the women's 200.

With this being Felix's first 200m of the season, her speed may not be where she wants it, but the defending

world champion easily handled the field as she crossed the line in 22.66 to a 1.9 win, 0.37 ahead of Richards.

Said Felix, "The speed was not there today. We still have to speed work, so I knew it wasn't going to be anything fantastic, but it shows where I really need the work."

LaShawn Merritt destroyed a very respectable field in the men's 200m as he finished 0.63 ahead of Xavier Carter's 20.07.

Afterwards he noted that he had been doing a good amount of speedwork over the winter and he just wanted to test the waters at the half-lap distance.

Even though he experienced some cramping while warming up he later said, "I didn't get out as hard because of it. It was a little sluggish. I was just going to build into it. I came off the curve and had the strength to hold."

Other notable performances came from Jeremy Wariner, who cruised 44.66 in the men's 400, Jenn Stuczynski, whose 15-7¼ won the women's vault by over a foot, Bernard Lagat, with an outstanding stretch run in the men's 1500 (3:36.38 AL) and Olympic 100 hurdles champion Dawn Harper (12.78), who showed good form besting Perdita Felician and defending world champion Michelle Perry.
