

— Barringer Joins The Sub-4:00 Club —



Barringer blasted by everybody but Burka in the straight

Eugene, Oregon, June 7—In a meet filled with Olympic medalists, Jenny Barringer of Colorado—the only collegiate athlete in the meet—stole the show at the 37th Prefontaine Classic.

The 22-year-old Buff senior came from far back on the final lap of the 1500, just missed catching Gelete Burka of Ethiopia, and became only the third American to break 4:00, running 3:59.90, 0.01 behind Burka.

It was the first sub-4:00 by an American since Suzy Favor-Hamilton did so in '02, and the first by an American woman in the U.S. since Mary Slaney's 3:58.92 at the 1988 Olympic Trials in Indianapolis.

Although known primarily as a steeplechaser—she will defend her NCAA title later this week in Arkansas—Barringer had come to Eugene in April and run a solo 4:08.38, trimming 3 seconds off her PR. Nevertheless, her appearance here, just days before the NCAA, was a surprise.

"We were hoping for the Collegiate Record," Colorado assistant Heather Burroughs said. "We thought she could run 4:02 or 4:03."

The race was just the second event on the 2-hour-long program and thus began at 11:10 in the morning local time, necessitated by the national telecast timed to conform to Eastern time.

There were plenty of fireworks to come as the capacity crowd of 12,841 were settling into their seats at Hayward Field. The men's long jump was just getting under way, and would be a titanic battle (see sidebar on next page).

In the dashes, two up-and-coming Americans burnished their CVs by winning the 100s.

Michael Rodgers, the little-known 24-year-old who went to Lindenwood and Oklahoma Baptist colleges, dominated a big-time field men's 100 field

in 9.94 (+1.7), a lifetime best and 2009 world leader.

Eight days earlier he won the Reebok 100 in New York in 9.93w, so everyone knows who he is now.

"I wanted to make a statement indoors and make a big bang outdoors," Rodgers said.

He beat four 2008 Olympians—Asafa Powell (10.07), Walter Dix (10.07), Travis Padgett (10.08) and Richard Thompson (10.09).

Powell, the Jamaican former WR holder, appeared to grandstand at the finish and look back at the runners beside him, not noticing that Rodgers, well to his left in lane 2, was already past the finish line.

Carmelita Jeter was up against half of the finalists from last year's OG 100 and dominated the race, running 10.85w (+3.2), defeating Olympic finalists Keron Stewart (10.90), Muna Lee (11.02), Shelly-Ann Fraser (11.10) and Lauryn Williams (11.12).

"It was a good race," said the 29-year-old Jeter. "I feel good. I'm going into outdoor champs as if I haven't won a thing."

In the women's 800, Maggie Vessey elected to stay off the pace, and it paid off. Jesse Carlin took the field through a 56.7 first 400, with Kenyan Pamela Jelimo, last year's dominant Olympic champion, on her shoulder. Vessey was clearly last.

Jelimo, a frontrunner, tied up at 600 as the entire field swept by, but it was Vessey who charged to the front down the straightaway to win in 2:00.18, well below her PR of 2:02.01 from a year ago.

Olympians Kenia Sinclair (2:01.02), Jemma Simpson (2:01.10 and Hazel Clark (2:01.12) finished together, while Jelimo straggled in last in 2:05.57.

By the time the Bowerman men's mile arrived, the sun was out and the temperature had crept into the middle 60s as 16 men, including two pacesetters, took the line. They took the

field through a torrid 55.4-1:52.9 first half-mile, and in the end it was Asbel Kiprop, the lanky 19-year-old Kenyan who won silver (or maybe gold?) in Beijing in the 15, who cruised in first, alternatively crossing himself and waving to the crowd the final hundred.

"The fans were so cheerful," he said, "I couldn't let them down. I had to wave."

He ran 3:48.50 in what was believed to be his mile debut. In all, 13 milers broke 4 minutes, but the Americans—Lopez Lomong, Evan Jager, Alan Webb, Will Leer and Leonel Manzano—were never a factor. Jager showed the most punch, however, with a huge PR, 3:54.35 in 7th. It was his first sub-4:00 race.

And of course, ditto for Jenny Barringer.

In her 1500, she stayed back of the fast pace, while Africans Burka, Nancy Lagat and Meskerem Assefa pushed at the front through 62-66 for the first 800. Barringer was 8th in

Phillips Finally Outjumps Saladino

The men's long jump brought together a heavyweight meeting of two Olympic champions, American Dwight Phillips, the '04 gold medalist, and Panama's Irving Saladino, the Beijing winner as well as the meet record-holder here.

A disappointed Phillips had failed to make last year's team, and he had lost nine times in a row to Saladino, going back to '05, although a week earlier in Hengelo, it was by just 2cm as Phillips became the first since '99 to jump 28-feet and lose.

"People had written me off because I had a couple of mediocre years," Phillips told Doug Binder of the *Portland Oregonian*. "But now I'm hungry and having fun."

Phillips opened up at 27-8 (8.43), Saladino 27-2½ (8.29). Then they got serious.

In round 3, Phillips erupted to 28-8¼ (8.74), into a 1.2mps wind, the first legal 28-foot jump in Hayward Field history.

Only Carl Lewis, Michael Powell, Bob Beamon and Robert Emmiyan have jumped farther. Phillips reacted by leaping onto the track, and he admitted later that he thought he might have broken Powell's WR.

Saladino was ready. He responded with 28-¾ (8.55), into a 1.5 wind. In round 4, he reached out to 28-3¼ (8.63) (-.04 wind), the No. 2 jump of his career (PR 8.73 in '08).

While Phillips passed, Saladino took two more shots but fouled on both. His final jump, into a 1.6 wind, appeared to be beyond 29 feet.

Phillips is thinking 29 as well. "I'm looking forward to the rest of the season," he said. The World Record "is my goal, and hopefully it will come around this year."

For Phillips, it was a PR by 5½" and was the longest jump on American soil since Carl Lewis jumped 28-10¼ in '83.

the early running. "I went into this race telling myself to be smart and just race," Barringer said.

With a lap to go, Shannon Rowbury, last year's top American, was on Burka's shoulder, but on the final backstretch she faded as fellow Yanks Anna Willard and Christin Wurth-Thomas and Russian Anna Alminova swept by.

And then, just as suddenly, here was Barringer as well. "I didn't go in thinking I could win," she said, "but with about 200 to go, I really thought I could win, and I raced like I could win."

That she did. With the crowd noise deafening and the clock pushing closer and closer to the magical 4:00, Barringer reached Burka just at the finish, losing 3:59.89-3:59.90, joining legends Slaney and Favor-Hamilton as the sub-4:00 American women. She broke the of (4:06.75) by nearly 7 seconds.

Willard ran 4:01.44 (7 US), Wurth-Thomas 4:01.92 (8 US), the first time three Americans have broken 4:02 in one race. Rowbury finished 6th in 4:03.92.

In the end, it was the competition that made it work for Barringer. "This meet is special because I actually got to race," she said. "I never led one step, and that was really important. I'm really proud to race with a ton of well-qualified professionals.... I wanted to be competitive today, and I'm glad I stuck with the plan.

"This is special," she said, "the best race of my career, but I'm really looking forward to NCAAAs."
