

# — Texas A&M Wins NCAA Men's Title —

Fayetteville, Arkansas, June 10–13—A mere 0.21 seconds was all it took to prevent an unprecedented 4-way tie for the 88th NCAA men's outdoor title.

Coming into the climactic 4x4, Oregon held the lead with 46 points, but without a stick team they were, as a *T&FN* message board reader put it, "sitting Ducks."

Pressbox reporters did quick calculations and figured if 3-time defending champ Florida State won the relay, with Texas A&M 3<sup>rd</sup> and Florida 4<sup>th</sup>, the biggest knot since a 1970 three-way BYU/Kansas/Oregon split would result (although that one actually came months later after some rescoring).

The Seminoles and Gators did their part for the scenario, but it wasn't the way Aggies anchor Justin Oliver wanted to make history.

Instead, he beat Baylor's Quentin Iglehart-Summers to the line for 2<sup>nd</sup> (3:00.91–3:01.12), giving A&M 48 points and its second championship ever—just a few minutes after the Aggie women provided the first (see the next newsletter).

The wins were the 28th and 29th career national titles for coach Pat Henry, who racked up 27 during his tenure at LSU, and his third men/women double.

Said a jubilant Oliver, "When it got to the 300 mark and I was still in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, I see the finish line, I see the trophy at the finish line waiting on me, 'Just drive,' that's all I thought. Just drive, pick 'em up, put 'em

down, pump your arms. And when I finally crossed the line, a million tons came off my back from all the work I've been putting in over the years, just came off at that moment.

four winners) vs. quantity, the latter won. The Aggies came into the final day with only 13 points but seven scoring opportunities, and made the most of them, including four athletes combining for 18 points in the triple jump.

Indoor champ Oregon came into the meet favored by 10 points, but gave other contenders hope when injured Matthew Centrowitz (picked to win the 1500) limped home last in his prelim, and fewer points than expected materialized in the 10,000 and javelin.

But those hopes then seemed dashed when the Aggie 4x1 squad made its third pass late and got a DQ.

But instead of despairing, the Aggies just bore down.

"During this meet, we ran out of the zone on the 4x1; we thought we were in trouble at that point, but this group bounced back very well," said Henry.

"You know, you have the fastest time in the country and you mess up an exchange on the end, and it's hard to bounce back from that. And I think that's about character. They showed

great character. We knew we still had an opportunity, we knew it was going to be tough, but we put it together and got after it."

In a high quality meet that provided no end of thrills for the spectators, year-leading performances were produced in no fewer than 11 of the 21 events.

It's easy to understand why: The Aggies grabbed their title with no individual champions. But in a battle of quality (Oregon had

## Key To NCAA Statistics

First names are not repeated within the same event, but are repeated in a second event. Paragraph-breaks in the middle of a prelim indicate the division between qualifiers and non-qualifiers.

All athletes are seniors unless marked with asterisks: \*\*\* = frosh; \*\* = soph; \* = junior; ' after name = non-American.

A combination of numbers and letters in parentheses, such as (x, 5 W), (3, 7 A) or (9, x C) indicates the athlete's position on the all-time top 10 performer and performances listings.

In the (x, 5 W) example the athlete has a better PR, therefore there is an "x" in the first position. But it's still the No. 5 world performance ever. (W=World; A=American; C= Collegiate; J=Junior; NCAA=NCAA Championships).

The (3, 7 A) example means that the person moves to No. 3 on the all-time U.S. performers list, with the No. 7 performance. And (9, x C) means the athlete becomes the No. 9 collegian ever, but the performance is outside the top 10. A number with "NCAA" indicates ranking in meet history. Marks making top 10s are bold-faced. Any major records are both bold-faced and printed in red.

We also denote yearly list leaders for the world (WL), U.S. (AL) and NCAA Div. I schools (CL).

All wind readings are in meters per second, and any positive reading over 2.0 (4.47 mph) is illegal ("w").
