A distant 7th was Britain's reigning WC and OG champion Christine Ohuruogu in 51.19.

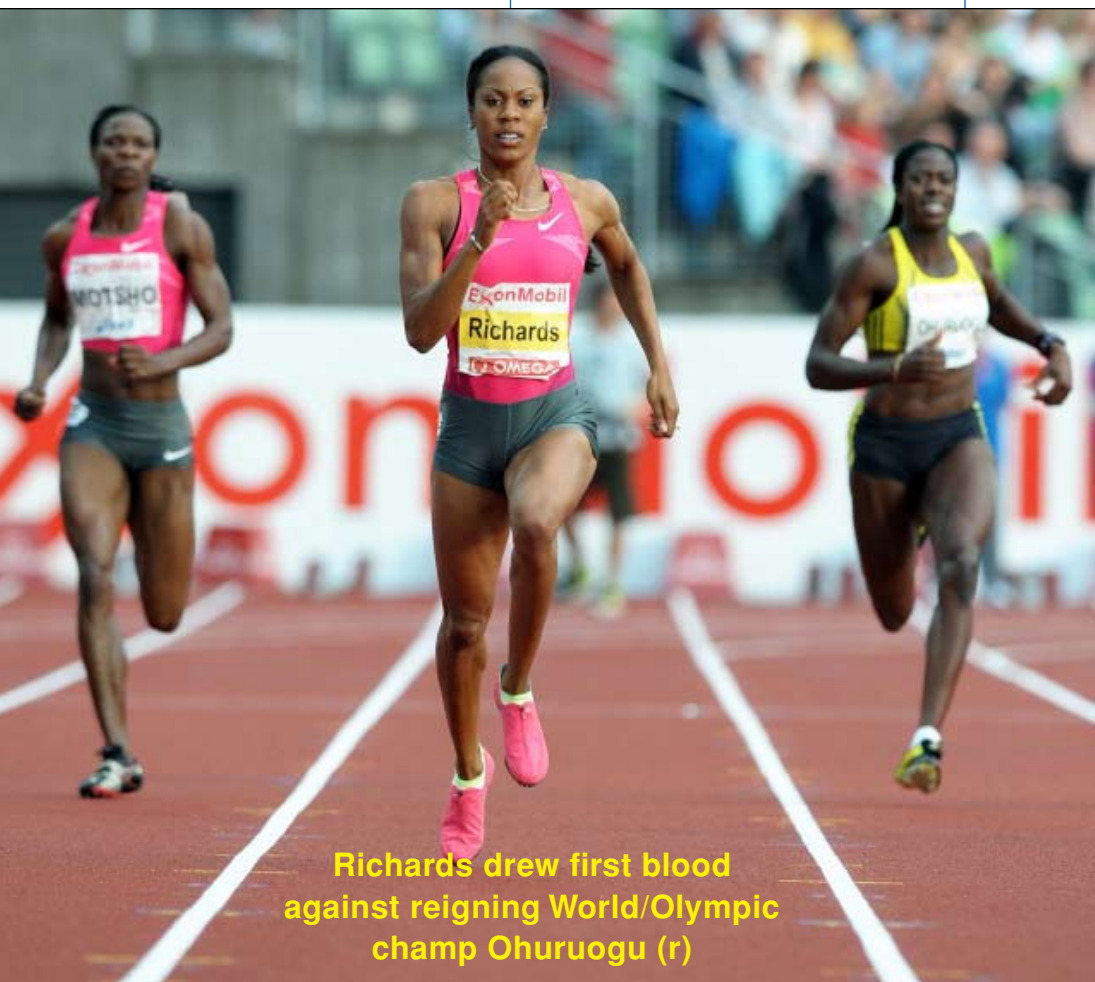
Richards now moves onto the next leg of the AF Golden League in Rome on Friday, where she'll clash with Williams again and also with USATF 200 champion Allyson Felix, who's no mean performer over the longer distance either.

Back in '07, Richards shared the Golden League's million-dollar jackpot with Russia's vault superstar Yelena Isinbayeva and the pair are among the six remaining contenders after two of the six meets in the series.

Isi wasn't exactly singing in the rain, with her competition one of the most seriously affected by the downpour, and was just happy to take a win on count back at 15-5½ (4.71) and keep her interest in the bounty alive.

The others who followed up their win in Berlin three weeks ago with a vic-

tory in Oslo were Ethiopia's Kenenisa Bekele (3000/5000), Finland's Tero Pitkämäki (JT)

It was the fastest lap of the track for Richards since she ran her American Record 48.70 AR back in '06, her fourth fastest 400 ever, and she hasn't been beaten in Golden League meets since Zurich '04.

"I'm not counting the races for the jackpot, that would give me too much pressure but I hope this will be my year, one way or another," she said. "I've haven't won any big medal, I was 4th in Beijing so maybe that will change in Berlin. I will work for that now."

Auburn alum Stewart was another who made up for defeat in her own WC Trials by winning well in 10.99, comfortably ahead of Trinidad's '08 NCAA champion, Kelly-Ann Baptiste, who clocked 11.14.

Bekele looked far less assured, still clearly not back to his imperious best after his injury problems of last fall, and had to work very hard over the last furlong of the 5000 to hold of the Kenyan-born Qatari James Kwalia, the pair coming home in 13:04.87 and 13:05.46.

Croatian high jumper Blanka Vlašić lost interest in the jackpot when she was beaten in Berlin by Ariane Friedrich, who skipped Oslo to compete in the German nationals, but the two-time reigning No. 1 World Ranker bounced back to win with 6-6¾ (2.00).

For the prolific Vlašić it was the 75th career meet over the 2-meter barrier.

U.S. champ Chaunte Howard kept up the pressure on the Croatian star, matching her jump-for-jump up to a equal-U.S.-list leading 6-6 (1.98) until she had three failures at 6-6¾.

The traditional Dream Mile can count the likes of middle distance icons Sebastian Coe, Steve Cram and Steve Ovett on its honor role and you can now add the name of Ethiopia's Deresse Mekonnen, who ran 3:48.95, 30 years after Coe had set a WR of exactly that same time in the same stadium.

Behind Mekonnen there was a new name to conjure with, Kenya's 19-year-old William Biwott, who went from fourth to second down the final stretch and finished in 3:49.29 for a new World Junior Record.

The old best of 3:50.25 was set by Kenyan Alex Kipchirchir in '03.
