

— Bolt Will Always Have Paris —

The weather gods haven't been very kind to Usain Bolt of late. After raining on his parade 10 days earlier in Lausanne, the unseason-

wind of 0.2mps.

While his margin was large, his late-race acceleration didn't appear quite as effortless as usual, due in large part to his training

for a track event in Paris since the '03 World Championships.

able European mid-summer storms followed the WR holder to the French capital for the Areva Golden League, but the Jamaican still managed to beat back the rain—along with a solid field—for a sizzling 100 win in front of 46,000-plus at the Stade de France.

Despite a sluggish start (“I still have to work on that before Berlin”) he pulled himself to the lead by midway and then reached the line unchallenged in 9.79, his fifth fastest legal clocking ever. He faced a minor head-

partners who made chase. Antigua Daniel Bailey continued his impressive summer, finishing 2nd in an NR 9.91, with Yohan Blake just a couple ticks behind in 9.93, the fastest ever by a teenager (he turns 20 the day before Christmas).

“It’s good to know that even if I get a bad start I can pick up at the end of the race,” said Bolt, whose appearance attracted more than 150 journalists to a premeet press conference two days earlier, and the biggest press turnout

Bernard Lagat/Kenenisa Bekele faceoff in the 3000. A middle-ground meeting between a speed guy and an endurance guy.

But the Ethiopian quickly halted any ideas Lagat may have entertained as jackpot spoiler after a sub-60 fourth lap, eventually winning handily in 7:28.64. Lagat was nonetheless pleased with his 7:33.15, an outdoor PR at age 34.

The '07 double world champion said he'll decide after his London mile and Stockholm kilo appearances if he'll defend both his titles in Berlin.

It took Yelena Isinbayeva just one jump—a first attempt clearance at 15-3 (4.65)—to stay in the jackpot chase, while Sanya Richards and Kerron Stewart continued to impress despite the conditions.

Fighting fairly strong headwinds on the backstretch, Richards still clocked 49.34, her second fastest run of the season, to win by more than a second over Jamaican Novlene Williams-Mills (50.39) while notching her 37th sub-50 to break her tie with WR holder Marita Koch for most in a career.

Stewart cruised to another comfortably victory in 10.99—Chandra Sturrup was a distant 0.16 back—and looks every bit as likely to go the distance in the series. Right now, she's the favorite for Berlin as well, and doesn't mind the target on her back.

"I know everyone's looking at me because of the time that I've run," she said, referring to her 10.75 in Rome a week earlier. "But it's what I've been working for. It's part of my job. It comes with the territory so I just have to embrace it."

Not looking like a favorite at the moment is two-time world 400 champion Jeremy Wariner. His 45.28 win against a modest field, even with the backstretch headwind, won't have Olympic champion LaShawn Merritt shaking in his spikes.

Pleased with the victory, the Texan nonetheless summed things up with a month to go before his title defense: "Obviously, I'm not ready."

Berlin-bound steepler and/or 1500 runner Anna Willard picked up the highest profile vic-

tory of her career with a come-from-behind 1:58.80 AL run in the 800, her second sub-2:00 in as many outings this season.

Dawn Harper also came from behind to take the 100 hurdles in 12.68, well ahead of Michelle Perry (12.75) and Ginny Powell (12.81).

In the men's highs, Dexter Faulk continued his break-out season in strong fashion, dominating in 13.14. Allen Johnson was a distant 7th in 13.67, a seasonal best for the 38-year-old.
