did well and was proud of myself. I got it right so I'm happy."

Bolt is clearly confident of being in top form for the World Championships and,

after staging his signature dance in front of the stands down the home straight where the majority of Jamaican fans were congregated, he laid out his plans:

"I'm still at 85%, and after this it's all training. I've got two or three weeks of good training to put in. So I guess I will be 100% by Berlin."

But just as much attention was focused on runner-up Yohan Blake, Bolt's training partner who finished a long way behind in 10.11, only to run into a media storm when he was named as one of five Jamaicans who had allegedly tested positive for an unnamed substance (one that apparently might carry only a minor penalty).

There were inevitably rumors about the athletes involved but luckily IAAF communications director Nick Davies was on hand to confirm that neither Bolt or Asafa Powell were among those suspected.

That was some consolation for former WR holder Powell, who came home a dismal 6th in 10.26 and for whom the gap to Bolt appears to be widening.

Said Bolt, "I'm not sure who it is yet; I'm sure it's not me so I'm not really worried. If it's someone from my group I don't know; I can't comment.

"Definitely it's sad to know there are still drugs but for me it doesn't really matter, as long as I'm clean I'm just going forward.

"It's sad for the sport because the sport was getting on so well; I was trying to bring it back. This is probably a step backwards because people start questioning everybody, especially from Jamaica.

"For me it doesn't matter because I will be going out there, day after day, doing my best. I get tested all the time. It shows that people get tested and they get caught if they are on drugs."

The negative publicity did not appear to be a distraction the second day when Blake returned to join Bolt and Mario Forsythe, plus Antigua's Daniel Bailey, representing the Kingston-based Racers Track Club, to win a special 4x1 in 37.46, the No. 4 time in history.

The Racers TC team was initially disqualified because the 19-year-old Blake broke too quickly at the start of the second leg. How-

ever, the judges changed their minds and the quartet was reinstated within 30 minutes.

An interested spectator in Bolt's performances was Tyson Gay, who won Saturday's 200 in 20.00 but noticeably slowed in the final few strides to help nurse a groin injury that is clearly causing him distress.

But, asked if Bolt should be wary of underestimating him, the American gave a confident reply. "Of course," he said, "because right now I'm running on faith and that's more dangerous than anything."

It all overshadowed a rare vault defeat for Yelena Isinbayeva, who saw her 18-meet winning streak broken.

The Russian star needed three attempts to clear her opening height of 15-4¼ (4.68) before failing at 15-8¼ (4.78), losing on the countback to Poland's Anna Rogowska.

"I'm not in form; I think I'm tired from competing, but I'm confident for Berlin," said Isinbayeva.

The latest in the aches, pain & eligibility departments:

The season is over for Florida State's NCAA 400 champion (in a Belgian Record 44.78) **Jonathan Borl e**, due to a right foot stress fracture.

Two-time Olympic 200 champ **Veronica Campbell-Brown** has recovered from the infected toe on her left foot that stalled her spring training when she was hit by a cramped or strained hamstring in the Athens 100.

Spain's **Mercedes Chilla**, the '06 Euro javelin bronze medalist, may miss the Worlds due to shoulder and back problems that may require surgery.

Three-time world discus champ **Franke Dietzsch** of Germany will try to defend her title in Berlin despite struggling with physical ailments and confidence issues. "I still believe the discus will fly far," says the 41-year-old.

Worlds participation is in question for France's **Ladji Doucour **, the '05 hurdle winner, following a right hamstring injury.

German discus thrower **Robert Harting**, 2nd in the '07 WC, has been bothered by back pain and says, "I won't be able to compete without pain."

World Junior vault champion **Rafael Holzdeppe** reinjured a left thigh muscle while winning the European Under-23 title and is questionable.

Not fully recovered from surgery on a shin stress fracture: Swedish hurdle star **Susanna Kallur**. Twin sister **Jenny Kallur** is also out.

Kenyan officials kicked national 10K champ **Sammy Kitwara** off the team after he competed in a road 10K without permission.

"They didn't tell me I couldn't compete after selection. Since this was my first time on the team, I saw nothing wrong with running," said the 27:44.46 runner.

Osaka 1500 silver medalist **Iryna Lishchynska** sprained an ankle warming up in Rome, so missed that race and London.

High hurdles star **Xiang Liu** wore spikes in training for the first time this year in mid-July. He hopes to return to competing either at the Shanghai GP in late September or China's National Games in October.

No Berlin for Russia's World Indoor pole vault champion **Yevgeniy Lukanenko**, after lymph node surgery.

Piotr Ma achowski, Poland's hope for

a discus medal, has an injury to the index finger of his throwing hand. He's throwing with pain and says if he doesn't throw well at the nationals next weekend he will not go to Berlin.

Out for the year while recovering from Achilles tendon surgery: Aussie 5000 man **Craig Mottram**.

Christine Ohuruogu pulled out of both the Paris Golden League and London GP meets due to a hamstring injury. Her WC 400 defense is in question.

Irish 100 hurdler **Derval O'Rourke** suffered a strained groin in her Euro Team Champs race, but is expected to be healthy for Berlin.

Worlds 400H defender **Jana Rawlinson** of Australia may miss Berlin after developing a bulging disk in her back.

A stress fracture in his foot has sidelined German decathlete **Michael Schrader** (8522 PR to win at G tzis), who figured to challenge for a medal in Berlin.

Olympic high jump champ **Andrey Silnov** of Russia is out for the year with an Achilles problem.

A persistent heel injury will British heptathlete **Kelly Sotherton** out of Berlin.

Vault veteran **Toby Stevenson** was slowed in '08 by hip and Achilles problems. But he is healthy this year and eager for the Worlds. He also acknowledged many had written him off last year. "That's the way the sport is," he says. "It's about what you've done lately and I hadn't done much lately.

"That aspect of being forgotten didn't bother me whatsoever—it's just part of the gig. If you can't handle that, you shouldn't be doing it."

Two-time world 400 champ **Jeremy Wariner** reunited this year with coach Clyde Hart and says they have worked especially on homestretch strength. "We've been working on strength endurance and speed endurance," Wariner says.

Beijing 1500 silver medalist **Nick Willis** of New Zealand won't run the 800 in Berlin as planned while he recovers from hip surgery. He may try to defend his Fifth Avenue Mile title later in September.
