Status Quo

ON THE EVE of the World Champs, more developments from the aches, pains and eligibility departments:

U.S. vault stars hurting—AR holder **Jenn Stuczynski** is expected to withdraw from Berlin momentarily due to ongoing tendinitis in her left Achilles. She hadn't competed since winning USATF while receiving treatment on the troublesome tendon. Stuczynski likely to be replaced by **Jillian Schwartz**.

And defending world champ **Brad Walker** took a jarring fall into the box in Monaco. X-rays and an MRI showed no damage, but he was quite banged up. He is expected to be recovered by the time of the qualifying round on August 20.

Mile AR holder **Alan Webb** plans to move from his home and training base of Reston, Virginia, to Portland, Oregon, to join with the Alberto Salazar-directed group. While one report said longtime coach Scott Raczkowski still might be involved with Webb's training, others indicated the athlete-coach break was complete.

Steepler **Anna Willard**, who developed into a 1:58.80/4:01.44 800/1500 runner this year, will contest only the 1500 in Berlin. The steeple spot now goes to Beijing Olympian **Lindsey Anderson**, 4th at this year's USATF. . . .

Out for the year while recovering from Achilles tendon surgery: Aussie 5000 star **Craig Mottram**; Olympic high jump champ **Andrey Silnov** of Russia.

INTERNATIONALLY: Well, fancy meeting you here! Reports are that **Usain Bolt** was entering the office of a noted German sports doctor when he encountered—**Tyson Gay**. The American had Dr. Hans-Wilhelm Müller-Wohlfahrt of Munich evaluate his groin problem. Bolt was to have a check on slight back pain. The two reportedly shared a little small talk, then moved on—next to meet in the Berlin 100.

Indoor 800 WR holder **Jolanda Ceplak** returned from a 2-year doping ban, but didn't plan to run at Worlds.

The status of Greek triple jumper **Piyi Devetzi** is up in the air. One report said she still is hampered by a "waist injury"—could that mean a groin?—and her future is unclear.

Olympic heptathlon champ **Natalya Dobrynska** of Ukraine plans to contest the long jump as well as the 7-eventer at Worlds. "I have no specific goals for the long jump," says the Ukrainian, who jumped a windy 22-1 (6.73) in Götzis this year. "I'll just try it and see how it works."

Steeple WR holder **Saif Shaheen** passed up his specialty at Worlds to run the 5000.

Olympic marathon winner **Sammy Wanjiru** will make his U.S. debut in Oc-

tober's Chicago Marathon.

Beijing 1500 bronze medalist **Nick Willis** decided against running the 800 in Berlin to recover from hip surgery. The New Zealander may try to defend his Fifth Ave. Mile title in late September.

Retirements: Israeli pole vaulter **Alex Averbukh** (twice Euro champ); British 400 sprinter **Tim Benjamin** (44.56 '05); Jamaican 400 veteran **Michael Blackwood**; Danish putter **Joachim Olsen** ('04 Olympic bronze); Germany's **Nils Schumann** ('00 Games 800 winner).

All Jamaicans Cleared

The five Jamaican sprinters who produced positive stimulant tests at their nationals were cleared by a disciplinary panel of the nation's Anti-Doping Commission.

Sheri-Ann Brooks was first cleared due to procedural problems with the confirming test of her B sample. Then **Yohan Blake**, **Marvin Anderson**, **Lansford Spence** and **Allodin Fothergill** also were cleared.

Panel chair Kent Gammon said the commission couldn't determine conclusively that the substance that produced the positive readings is found on the WADA banned list.

The Jamaica Anti-Doping Commission plans to appeal the decision and the IAAF also will review the findings.

More Jamaican Drama

Just as happened last year at Jamaica's pre-Beijing training camp, several members of the MVP Club did not appear for a reportedly mandatory pre-WC camp in Nurnberg. The group included sprint stars **Shelly-Ann Fraser** and **Asafa Powell**, 400 runner **Shericka Williams** and 100 hurdler **Brigitte Foster-Hylton**. All are coached by MVP head Stephen Francis.

Some reports claimed that the non-appearance by the athletes could make them ineligible for Jamaica's team in Berlin.

Agent Paul Doyle explained that the group wanted to stay in Italy for training and medical attention. But MVP members **Michael Frater**, **Markino Buckley**, **Christine Day** and **Anneisha McLaughlin** did report to the camp.

BRAZILIANS POSITIVE: Six Brazilian athletes were revealed to have produced positive A results in June out-of-competition testing.

One-lap hurdler **Lucimar Teodoro**, men sprinters **Bruno de Barros** and **Jorge Sena**, plus women **Josiane Tito** (400), **Luciana Franca** (400H) and **Lucimara da Silva** (heptathlon).

Two club coaches admitted giving all but Teodoro injections of EPO without their knowledge.
