#### ATTENDANCE

#### WEATHER

Official temperature—both F and C—and humidity readings are given with each event.

#### EXPLAINING THE TYPOGRAPHY

Paragraph breaks in the preliminary rounds of running events indicate the separation between qualifiers and non-qualifiers.

#### COLOR CODING

All medalists appear in blue ink; all Americans are in bold face and italics (if in multiple rounds, only in the final round in which they competed); field-event/multi medalists appear in either blue (gold medal), red (silver) or green (bronze) in the progression charts.

#### SPLIT TIMES

Times in 10ths were taken by the *T&FN* split crew (virtually completely by video analysis); times in 100ths are either eyebeam times from the official timer, Seiko, or high-speed video research done by the IAAF Biomechanics Team. We thank them for their invaluable work.

#### FIELD CHARTS

In the by-round field charts (all throws, horizontal jumps), the athlete’s best of the day is underlined. The asterisked marks represent the progression of the lead. This includes those with subsequent drug DQs, since the intent is to demonstrate how the event played out in its proper historical perspective.

#### WHAT’S IN VERSION ii?

Note that this newsletter is marked as “version ii”; this means history tells us that more small amendments will roll in as more tape is watched and more sources are uncovered. While we won’t e-mail you the updated version, we will make a note of it in a subsequent *TN* and if you wish you’ll be able to download it from the Archive.

## Laser Gets Bolt's Top End

In addition to the 20-meter splits captured by high-speed cameras for the final, the research teams also measured Bolt's speed/splits from behind with a laser. These splits are not as accurate as the 20m ones (can be off by about 0.02):

**1.89, 0.99 [2.88], 0.90 [3.78], 0.86 [4.64], 0.83 [5.47], 0.82 [6.29], 0.81 [7.10], 0.82 [7.92], 0.83 [8.75], 0.83 [9.58].**

**The laser says Bolt's top speed was 12.27mps (27.45mph) at 65m.**
