EXPLAINING THE TYPOGRAPHY

Paragraph breaks in the preliminary rounds of running events indicate the separation between qualifiers and non-qualifiers.

COLOR CODING

All medalists appear in blue ink; all Americans are in bold face and italics (if in multiple rounds, only in the final round in which they competed); field-event/multi medalists appear in either blue (gold medal), red (silver) or green (bronze) in the progression charts.

SPLIT TIMES

Times in 10ths were taken by the *T&FN* split crew (virtually completely by video analysis); times in 100ths are either eyebeam times from the official timer, Seiko, or high-speed video research done by the IAAF and DLV (German Federation) Biomechanics Team. We thank them for their invaluable work.

FIELD CHARTS

In the by-round field charts (all throws, horizontal jumps), the athlete’s best of the day is underlined. The asterisked marks represent the progression of the lead. This includes those with subsequent drug DQs, since the intent is to demonstrate how the event played out in its proper historical perspective.

WHAT’S IN VERSION ii?

Note that this newsletter is marked as “version ii”; this means history tells us that more small amendments will roll in as more tape is watched and more sources are uncovered. While we won’t e-mail you the updated version, we will make a note of it in a subsequent *TN* and if you wish you’ll be able to download it from the Archive.

The Screwed-Up 10K Start

When starting a 10K in two groupings, IAAF rules mandate only that there be a cone to mark the cut-in point. Nonetheless, it is considered standard procedure to put a whole row of cones out as a guide.

This was not done in the Berlin women's race, and as a result, the 8 athletes who started in the outer grouping—Agafonova, Ayalew, Félix, Masai, Momanyi, Nakamura, Sahaku & Zhang—cut in early, shaving perhaps 7–8 meters off their route.

Although there was much mumbling about protests, in the end nobody was DQed and the results were left to stand. Given that it was a situation as much the fault of the officials as the athletes, it's a tough decision to find fault with. But the times should not appear at face value on any list.
