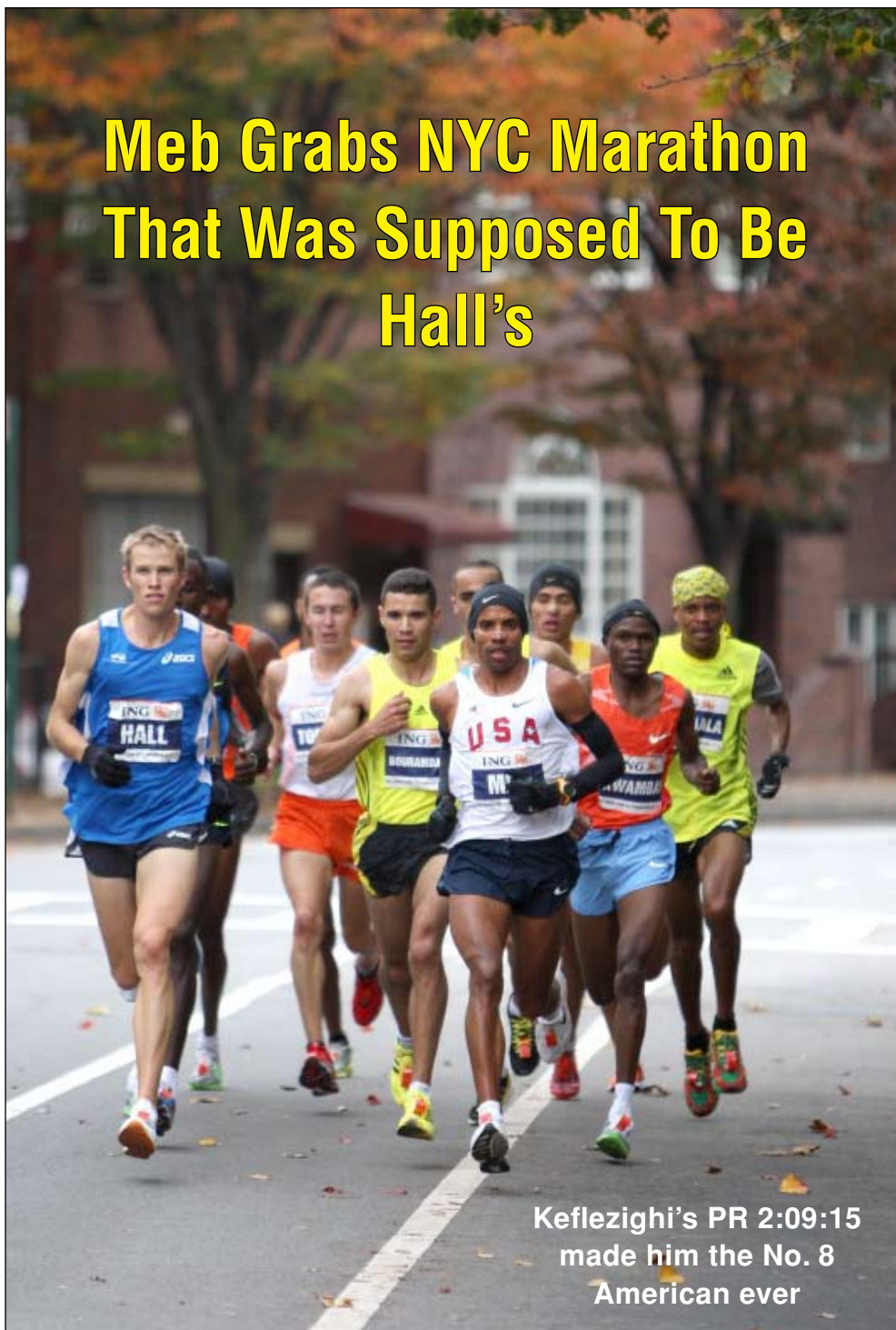


### Meb Grabs NYC Marathon That Was Supposed To Be Hall's

New York City, November 1—Ryan Hall was literally the poster boy for American distance aces looking to steal the New York City Marathon. His image was plastered on ads throughout the five boroughs, but it was a surprising Meb Keflezighi who ended a 27-year-drought for the U.S. in the Big Apple.

Wearing his national-team singlet, Keflezighi carefully paced himself before finally laying down a convincing surge in Central Park to steal the race from four-time Boston winner Robert Cheruiyot in a PR 2:09:15. The '04 Olympic silver medalist became the first American man to win here since Alberto Salazar in '82.

Martin Lel, in the eyes of many the favorite coming in, withdrew a couple of days before the race, citing lingering injury.

A dozen runners—including five Americans—followed Abderrahim Bouramdane through halfway in 1:05:07. The Moroccan had thrown in numerous surges, though none were decisive.

A 3-mile sequence of 4:42, 4:40 and 4:47 between markers 17 and 19 up First Avenue quickly thinned the lead pack to seven, and at 20 miles Cheruiyot, Keflezighi, Bouramdane and Kenyan James Kwambai were the final four.

After Bouramdane and Kwambai fell off, Keflezighi made his big move at 24 miles, and Cheruiyot (2:09:56) had no response.

Beijing silver medalist Jaouad Gharib of Morocco (2:10:25) and Hall (2:10:36), back in 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> at the 18-mile mark, regained their composure over the final miles and finished 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>.

In all, six Americans finished in the top 10 for the first time since the race expanded to all five boroughs in '76. Jorge Torres, making his 26-mile debut, finished 7<sup>th</sup> in 2:13:00.

Said Keflezighi, "It's a wonderful day for myself and the rest of the American guys. You visualize, you visualize, but when reality hits, it hits

home, and it's pretty sweet."

Keflezighi was deeply humbled to have ascended to the top of the sport. The 34-year-old native of Eritrea, a U.S. citizen since 1998, broke his right hip at the Olympic Trials two years ago in Central Park, and many had counted him out for good. Support from coaches, training partners and his wife got him through the tough road back.

And spectators gave him an extra push on race day. "Wearing that USA jersey got the crowd going," he said, "and I definitely wore it with big honor and pride."

In the women's race, which started a half-hour earlier, 37-year-old Ethiopian Derartu Tulu comfortable won her first New York title as Paula Radcliffe lost a 26.2-mile footrace for only the third time in her career.

Radcliffe set an unremarkable 5:40 tempo for much of the race, briefly picking up speed between 15 and 20 kilometers. Five women—Tulu, Radcliffe, French discovery Christelle Daunay, Boston champ Salina Kosgei of Kenya and 41-year-old workhorse Ludmila Petrova—hit halfway in 1:14:05 (compared to 1:13:23 last year, when Radcliffe won her third NYC title in 2:23:56).

The WR holder, her trademark headbobbing beginning to intensify, was suffering from complications from a left hamstring injury that surfaced during a track workout two weeks ago.

"The first 10 miles felt great," Radcliffe said after the race. "Then at 11 miles, and going over the Queensboro Bridge, it got really painful... apparently my femoral nerve in my back started to shut my leg down. I couldn't believe I was going that slow and still in touch."

Approaching the 23<sup>rd</sup> checkpoint Petrova took control, a 5:45 enough to break Radcliffe. Within minutes Daunay was also a goner, and Tulu looked like she was out for a jog as Petrova wore a grimace that grew more pained by the minute.

As they curved back into Central Park for the final climb to the finish, Tulu finally turned on the jets, gapping Petrova with a sprint that had previously carried her to Olympic 10,000 titles in '92 and '00, as well as a world championship in 2001.

Tulu crossed the line in 2:28:52, eight seconds up on Petrova, the third smallest margin of victory in race history, and the slowest winning time since '90.

Daunay (2:29:16) held off Radcliffe (2:29:27) to grab the final spot on the podium. "It's been three years since I gave birth to my second child," Tulu said. "During that time I struggled a great deal to lose weight

and to regain endurance." A 1:10:33 at the Philadelphia Distance Run half marathon on September 20 told her she was ready to once again become a factor at the elite level.

Magdalena Lewy Boulet (3:32:17) finished 6<sup>th</sup>, the top American woman.

Joan Benoit Samuelson, running with the masses, crossed the line in 2:49:09, an impressive run—the fastest ever by an over-50 runner—that placed the '84 gold medalist 17<sup>th</sup> against the elite women.
