

— NCAA Men's Cross To Chelanga, Ok State —

Terre Haute, Indiana, November 23—Sammy Chelanga of Liberty and the Oklahoma State team rebounded from last year's NCAA Cross Country disappointment to score impressive wins in the 2009 chase.

Kenyan junior Chelanga showed a little patience before zipping away from the field in a simply stunning run to record a 25-second win in 28:41.3.

"I realized that last year I went out too hard in the first mile, and I died," he said of the losing end of his duel with Galen Rupp.

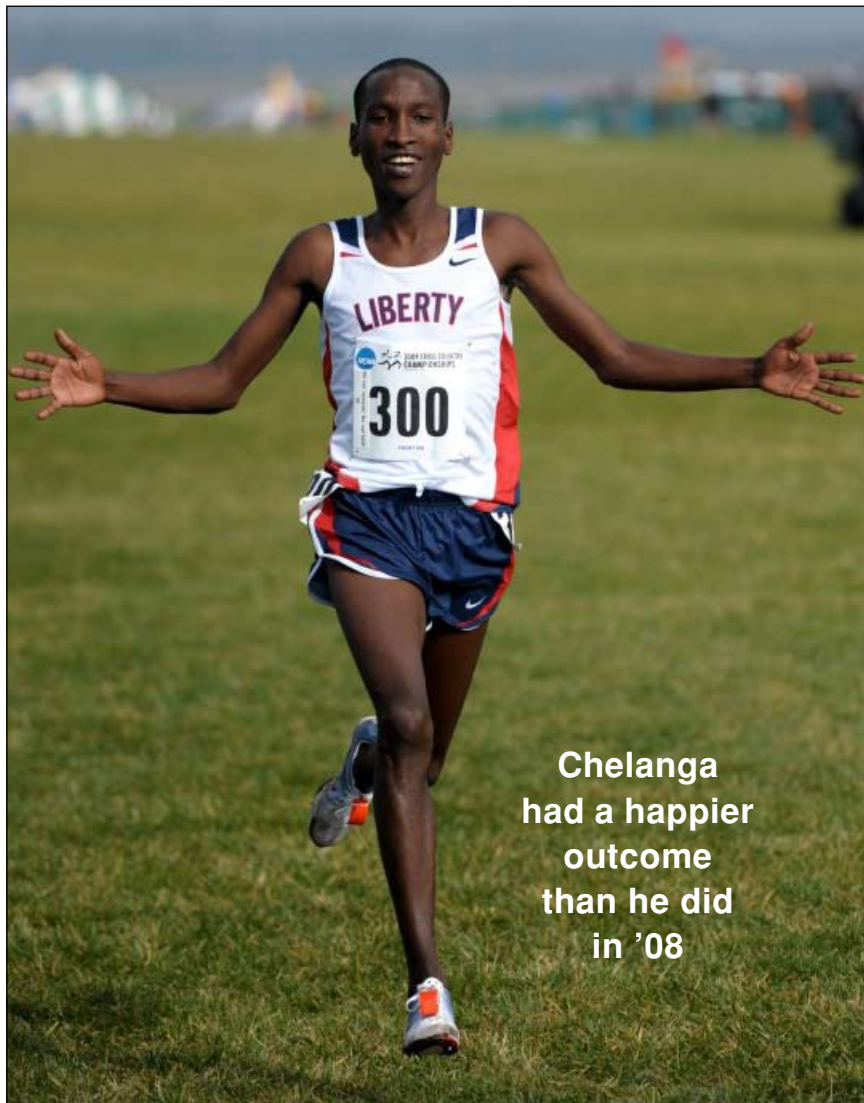
"This year I didn't even care what the first mile was," the collegiate 10,000 recordholder recounted. "I was just relaxing. Before the second mile somebody yelled that you have a 5-second lead, and I was even trying so I thought that I might as well hop on that and keep going.

"I had a good stride until 9K when I got a stitch, but when I saw the finish line I thought, 'Wow, this is awesome.'"

Ryan Vail led victorious Oklahoma State to a 128-point tally. The Cowboys' senior captain grabbed the 9th-place stick (7th in team terms), with soph Colby Lowe finishing 10th, senior John Kosgei 13th, and soph Girma Mecheso 28th. Soph mile star German Fernandez (97th) made the best of a bad day to lock down the win.

"Last year we went through the pressure cooker; it was tough," OSU coach Dave Smith admitted. "Last year we were like deer in the headlights, this year we

were more poised and relaxed."

Smith's strategy was simple "I told the guys to stick with Ryan Vail through 8K: 'Let him do the thinking for you.' He's our team quarterback, an incredibly poised, confident patient runner, and he doesn't have bad days."

Oregon finished 16 points back, with favored Stanford crumbling and ending up only 10th.

— NCAA Women's XC Titles To Bizzarri & Villanova —

Illinois senior Angela Bizzarri won a surprise NCAA women's cross country title, running 19:46.8 in a 6-kilo race that had been pegged as a duel between Colorado's Jenny Barringer and Florida State's Susan Kuijken.

Running in her last collegiate race, Barringer, the runner-up in '06 and '07, felt light-headed in the third kilometer while running out front with Kuijken. The Buffalo senior stumbled and fell and then struggled just to finish, crossing the line 163rd in 21:46.9.

Said the favorite, "I just lost my head and didn't feel good and then next thing I knew I was on the ground thinking, 'Is this really happening to me? Is this a race?'"

Kuijken, 2nd last year, looked like a runaway winner with Barringer down, but she tired entering the race's final kilo and faded to 3rd in 19:57.7.

Bizzarri, the reigning track 5K champ, and Washington's Kendra Schaaf caught Kuijken with 800 meters to go, then Bizzarri romped down the homestretch, winning in 19:46.8. Schaaf, a soph who finished 12th last year, ran 19:51.6.

"There was kind of shock going into the last straightway," Bizzarri admitted. "Even the last 600 meters it was a shock just knowing I had the chance to win."

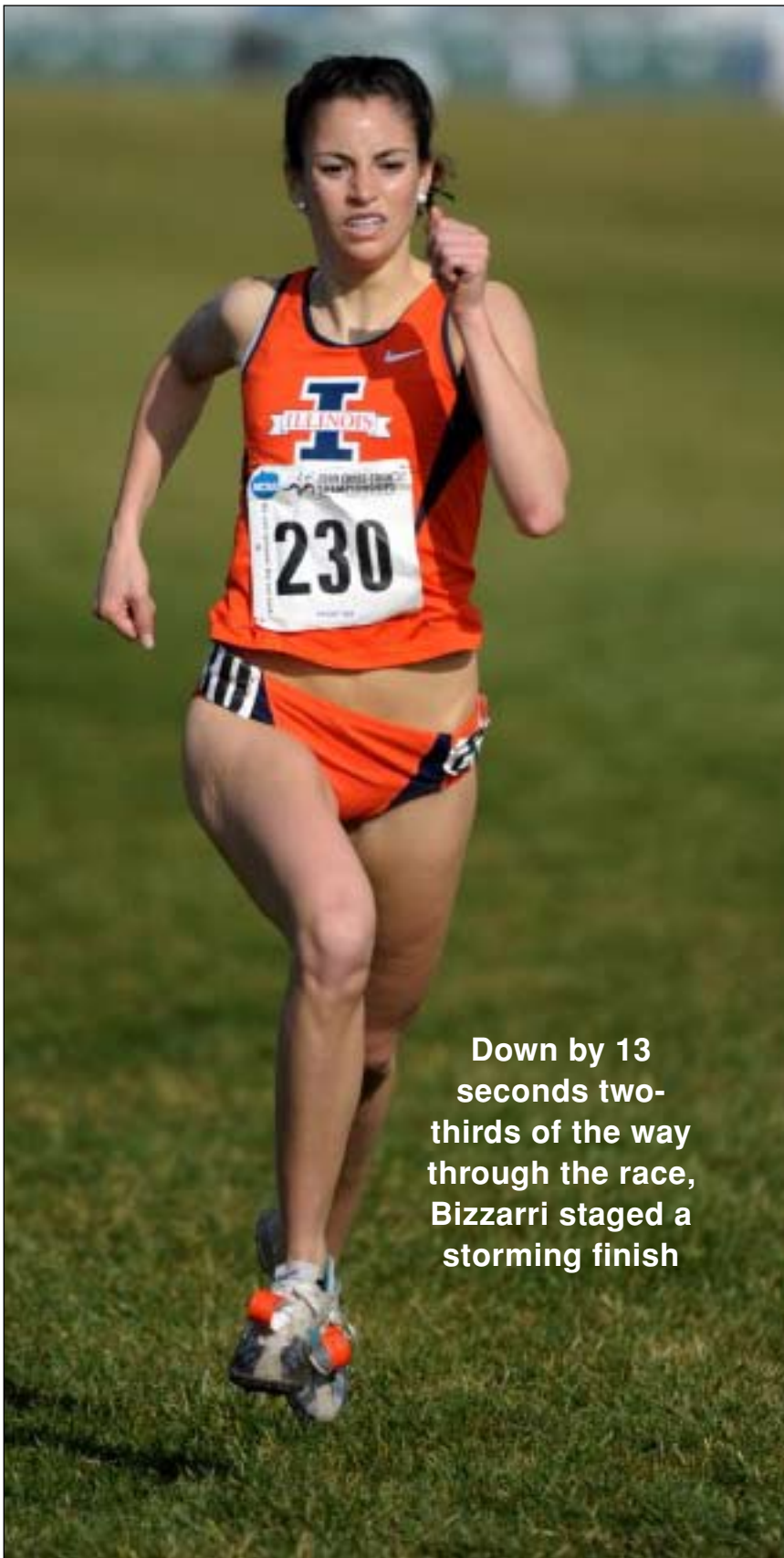
Villanova, history's winningest women's program with seven team titles coming into the meet, earned No. 8 with a persuasive victory. The young squad, ranked No. 2 behind Washington coming in, tallied 86 points to easily top Florida State's 133 and defending champion Washington's 188.

The Villanova scorers—junior Amanda Marino 6th, soph Sheila Reid 13th, soph Bogdana Mimić 22nd, junior Alison Smith 24th, senior Nicole Schappert 30th—were separated by only about 50 seconds and the Wildcats would have won even if Marino were swapped out for the next finisher, frosh Brooke Simpson in 60th.

"The first interval workout [this year], I thought, 'Man, they look as good as the '94 team and the '98 team,'" said head coach Gina Procaccio, a Nova alum and assistant coach in the '90s.

The 2009 Wildcats proved her right.
