

— Flanagan's Debut A Successful One —

HOUSTON, Texas, January 17—With an eye on a marathon career farther down the line, track 5K/10K AR holder Shalane Flanagan stepped up to the half-marathon distance for the first time at the USATF Championships.

It was an auspicious debut, as she moved to No. 5 on the all-time U.S. list with her 69:41 win.

Those Americans ahead of her: Kara Goucher 66:57, Deena Kastor 67:34, Joan Samuelson 68:34, Cathy O'Brien 69:39.

"The primary goal was to win the race," said the 28-year-old Olympian. "Everything else was a bonus. I feel like I gave a really good effort, but I actually feel like I have more running in my legs. That's a good sign to me."

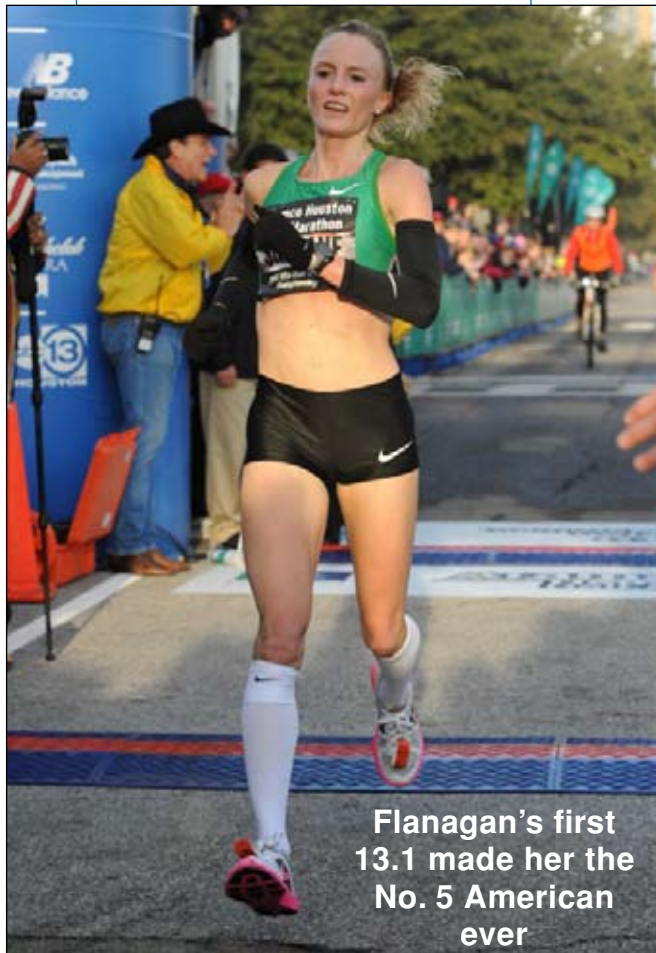
