

— Goodwin Transitioning From Football —

College Station, Texas, January 23—*T&FN* has editorialized many times that a return of the dual meet could be, if not the savior of the sport on the NCAA level, then at least a way of re-injecting some life and fan interest.

Anyone doubting this position should have heard the passionate screams from the stands during the women's 4x4 at Texas A&M's Gilliam Indoor Track & Field Stadium, as the defending outdoor national champion Aggies fought with the Texas Longhorns

to settle a deadlocked meet.

The two fierce rivals entered the final event tied at 75½ each, and that evenness continued throughout the relay. On the last leg, Texas's Angele Cooper rebuffed repeated challenges from outdoor silver medalist Jessica Beard for a 3:35.39–3:35.60 win.

The result set off a noisy eruption from the Texas faction, a sound not heard often enough in non-championship college meets. (The men's side had less drama, with the other outdoor champion from '09 whomping Texas 92–64.)

While the team aspect stirred up passions in the Lone Star State, national interest centered on the remarkably fast transition high school long jump record holder Marquise Goodwin of Texas has made from the football field to the track.

The weekend prior, in a dual against Arkansas—a mere nine days after playing in the Longhorns' unsuccessful BCS title attempt—he uncorked wins in the 60 (6.69) and the LJ (25-4/7.72).

Against A&M, he improved his jump to 25-7½ (7.81) and placed 2nd in the 60 (6.82) to Aggie Gerald Phiri's 6.68, despite a stumble out of the blocks.

Being tied for No. 3 on the college LJ list and No. 5 in the 60 as a frosh would be impressive enough, but getting there on so little event-specific training turned heads.

Goodwin said he put in two practices

before the Arkansas meet and three before Arkansas.

"I've been doing this since high school," Goodwin said of the transition, "but it's different in college because the seasons are a lot longer. It's pretty fun, but the transition to track is going good."

Goodwin admitted that he had some soreness after "getting banged up" on the gridiron, "but I just have to work through it. You ice it down and get treatment every day." Goodwin won't be jumping in next week's Big 12/SEC/Pac 10 Challenge.

Was he surprised to hit 25 so quickly on so little practice? "It was a goal of mine," he says casually. "I had a few days to work on it, and I did."

"If he can consistently be in the mid-26 range it's gonna be a good indoor season, and once he becomes consistent at that, then there could be a 27-foot jump in there," said Texas head coach Bubba Thornton.

"But I really don't like to talk about those things. The thing about Marquise I've watched and I've witnessed is he really knows how to compete and doesn't waste those moments. A lot of people think they're going to get another opportunity, and... they don't get their maximum effort each time. He has the ability to do that."

Those kind of marks would surpass Texas' indoor LJ record of 26-even – held by another of the school's football/track legends, one Eric Metcalf, the '86 NCAA champ who went on to NFL stardom. Goodwin's high school record is 26-10.

Surprisingly, Goodwin – not even born until 1990—was well aware of Metcalf. "He was at the track my senior year of high school at the Texas Relays," Goodwin said. "I knew who he was."

Did they talk about Metcalf's record? "He brought it up," says Goodwin. "He asked coach, 'Is this the guy who's gonna take my name off that wall?'"
