

— Lagat Claims AR In Reebok Boston 5K —

Roxbury Crossing, Massachusetts, February 6—Bernard Lagat did not disappoint. Neither did the supporting cast assembled for the men's 5000 at edition No. 15 of the Reebok Boston Indoor Games at the Reggie Lewis Track & Field Center.

Lagat's American-Reebok record 13:11.50 performance in—believe this or not—the first indoor 5000 this 35-year-old vet of the global racing whirl had ever run, was hot stuff.

So were the four great performances in his wake—all under 13:19—that had the Reggie-goers really into it.

The indoor 5 can be a rip-roaring, crowd-inciting, nail-biter of an event.

It's just too darn bad, though, that it's so intermittently included in the indoor circuit's big-meet schedule of events.

They run the indoor 5 at the NCAAs and conference meets but not the USATF Nationals.

They run it at a few major stops on the global indoor tour—Birmingham, Stockholm, Prague, Dusseldorf, Ghent and some more in Europe, but not in the IAAF Worlds.

Of course, the corps of world-class runners who'd be asked to run more of these grinding indoor 5s might not be very happy with the suggestion.

But the fans sure love it, as they once more demonstrated when the 14-man field lined up for this one.

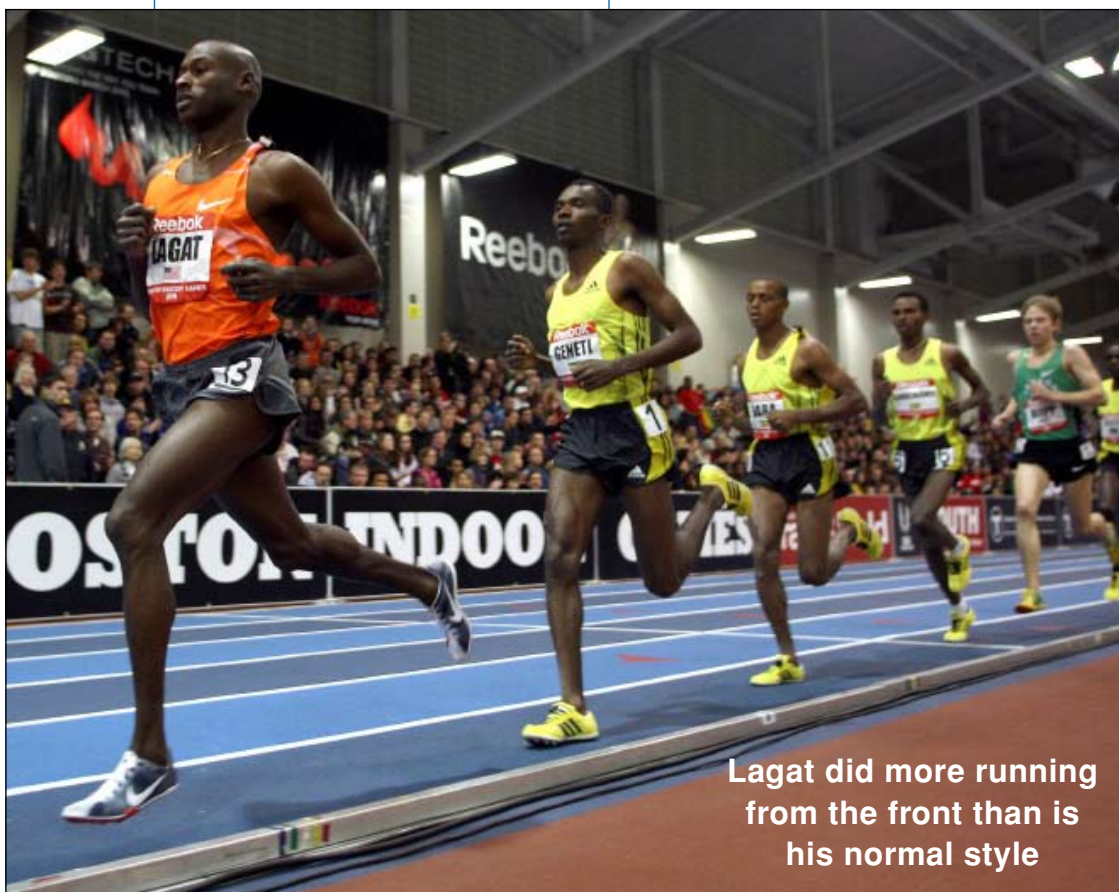
With plenty of Ethiopian flags being waved by members of Boston's considerable community from the East African nation, with Dejen Gebremeskel, Bekana Daba and Markos Geneti in the field, the applause-meters were already being put to the test.

And when they got down to introducing Galen Rupp and Bernard Lagat—backed by lots of "USA, USA, USA" support from the stands—fans figured they were in for a special kind of treat.

The rabbits (four of them) brought the other 10 around in 2:06 for four laps and 4:14 for eight, only to see things slow two laps later.

It now became a strategic contest. Rupp

They got the excitement they wanted.

Heading into this one, the 15 fastest indoors 5s—a list topped by Kenenisa Bekele's 12:49.60 at Birmingham in '04—had been run in Europe. The fastest ever run in North America, Daba's 13:17.89 verdict over Rupp's AR 13:18.12 at Fayetteville last year, ranked just 16 and 17.

If only Lagat and other members of the stellar cast had poured more into the mid-race pace, they'd have delivered something closer to the magic 13:00-mark.

eased up to third past 3000 meters and at 4000 had the lead. Now, it was down to the two Americans and three Ethiopians.

But at 4700 Lagat was ready to turn sprinter and, once he got up onto his toes,

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there was no stopping him. He scorched a 27-second last lap to complete his 13:11.50.

It was both an AR and World all-time No. 13. Oh yes, a meet record: while they've had lots of women's 5s here before, this was the first time the men got to run the 25-lapper.

In his wake, as everyone PRed came Gebremeskel and Daba (both 13:11.78), Rupp (13:14.21) and Geneti (13:18.64.)

Two more broke 13:30: Kenya's Shadrack Korir (13:26.82) and Josphat Boit (13:27.42), with Villanova grad Bobby Curtis 8th (13:36:00.)

Lagat's trademark tactic has always been to hang with the pack, then come up with the huge, race-breaking move from the back at the precise moment of maximum impact.

But this time—after the rabbits were gone, and before Rupp's own surge—he ran much of it from the front.

"I was determined to push it hard, but it wasn't hard enough until Galen came up to push the final K," said Lagat. "I think we dropped four seconds [from race pace] in that

last K, so I think we did a good job.

"The indoor 5,000 meters? It's like different territory."

For Rupp, call it an educational venture. He'd been battling a head cold all week, but wouldn't agree to bailing out of the meet.

Coach Alberto Salazar had suggested a last-minute switch to the mile, but Rupp, backed by his support team, wasn't buying.

So he stuck to his original intent and came up with a time that also broke his former AR.

For a moment before the start, fans may have thought Rupp was bailing out of the meet altogether. As the others were being introduced, he hopped over the back rail of the track and rushed away. But it was only a quick trip to the comfort station.

Lots of other good stuff marked the compact, 2:50 program.

New Zealand's Nick Willis came back from hip trouble and a year's absence from the global circuit to post the year's fastest mile, 3:55.26, fighting off the gutsy Chris Leer (3:55.66) with four more subs 4s next in line.

Tirunesh Dibaba won the women's 5 in 14:44.53, with Sally Kipyego of Kenya her only serious challenger at 14:52.67.

A pair of 18-year-olds, Kalkidan Gezahegn (8:46.19) and Genzebe Dibaba, the third of the sisterly team (8:47.01) went 1-2 in the women's 3, as all those Ethiopian flag-wavers continued getting a great workout, too.

Terrence Trammell breezed past the hurdle field in 7.49 and thought he had matched the world-leading time he'd notched at Millrose. Only later did he learn that Dayron Robles of Cuba had run 7.48 earlier that day in Stuttgart.
