

### 46TH NCAA MEN'S INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

# Eaton Breaks Heptathlon WR

Fayetteville, Arkansas, March 12–13—The men's side of the NCAA Indoor Championships was to be a showcase for the dashes and for the host Razorbacks to take advantage of some home cookin'.

Well, the sprinters and the Hogs provided outstanding results, but out of the blue—or was that yellow & green?—came a performance that appropriately outdid all the other events, combined.

Oregon senior Ashton Eaton set a World Record in the heptathlon, besting Dan O'Brien's score of 6476, set in the '93 World Championships in Toronto.

What is equally impressive is that Eaton recorded personal (indoor) bests in every event on his way to his 6499 total.

His journey began with a 6.71 in the 60, followed by 25-4½ (7.76) leap in the long jump, a 43-½ (13.12) toss in the shot, and a 6-11 (2.11) high jump to finish with a 3561 first-day total.

On Day 2, he picked up where he left off, with a 7.77 hurdle PR and a 16-8¾ (5.05) vault.

That left the kilo, where Eaton would have to he would have to run 2:34.58 to better O'Brien's record.

His best coming into the meet was 2:38.02, so a 4-second improvement was what was needed.

Fortunately, Curtis Beach was in the field. In addition to being a top-flight multi-eventer, the Duke frosh is no slouch in the 800, having already run a 1:47.9 split earlier this year in a distance medley.

Eaton and North Carolina senior Mateo Sossah were on Beach's heels throughout the

race, covering each 200-meter lap in 30–31 seconds.

With just over a lap to go Beach took off, leaving Eaton and Sossah to fend for themselves. The young Blue Devil crossed the line in 2:27.88, a world best in itself for a 1000 run in heptathlon competition. The story, however, was in 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Sossah passed Eaton on the final circuit, but the defending champion did not wilt. He hung on to finish in 2:32.67, a PR by more than 3.5 seconds and 23 points better than O'Brien's global standard.

Eaton said that he knew the record was a possibility after the first day: "A lot of times guys say that they are not thinking about records, but last night, I went to bed thinking that a record was possible."

When asked about the final event, he added, "I had my doubts and didn't think I would have what it takes, but coming into three laps on pace I knew that I had it.

"I kept looking at the clock and saw the pace, all my doubts were gone. It was a true Cinderella story; everything was set up perfect and fell into to place. All thanks to the crowd. This is like nothing I have ever had before and I feel nervous about the future."

The men's 60 was to be a showdown of sorts between Florida's Jeff Demps, Auburn's Marcus Rowland and Texas A&M's Gerald Phiri.

In the end it was the Ga-

tors' Demps, who utilized his gridiron explosiveness to get the jump on the field and cross the line first in 6.57, 0.03 ahead of Phiri.

The win was not only important to Demps on a personal level, but he knew how crucial a win would be for his team. He said, "The whole race I was about my team and getting those 10 points. During the race I kept looking beside me and got excited early but I knew I had it. It feels good and I feel good and I hope for a national championship."

Florida got a lot more points from jump specialist Christian Taylor. On Friday, the Gator soph jumped 26-¾ (7.93), good enough for second behind Arkansas' Alain Bailey (26-¾/8.17) in the long jump.

The next day, he dominated the field in the triple jump with his 56-4½ (17.18), winning by almost a yard. His 18 points accounted for nearly a third of the Gators' victorious total.

It's always nice to have the home crowd on your side and it was now Dorian Ulrey's time to experience the thrill. On Friday night, the Razorbacks were co-favorites with Oregon to take the DMR.

However, Oregon Olympian Andrew Wheating was threw a wrench into the works and ran down Ulrey off the final turn, spoiling Arkansas' chance for victory on their home boards.

On Saturday, Ulrey exacted his revenge, using the slow pace to his advantage in the 3000. He waited for the opportunity and pounced when the time was right. With 1000m remaining the real running began. As the pace quickened, Ulrey and Northern Arizona's David McNeil, who had already won the 5000m the night before, were dueling down the backstretch. When they came off the final turn it was Ulrey who sprinted to the tape in first, 0.44 ahead of McNeill.
