# Oregon's Juggernaut Rolls

Denizens of Stanford track meets used to joke that former Cardinal Coach Vin Lananna cast spells to order up the perfectly distance-friendly weather at meets on The Farm.

Now that he is in charge in Eugene, ideal weather is too great a work of wizardry even for Lananna, but he did produce a bit of magic, even if from afar, having stayed back in Eugene due to blood pressure issues, as the Ducks compiled an impressive winning score of 61 points, 25 ahead of runners-up Tennessee, last year's champs, to win their first NCAA Indoor title.

The Ducks' point total was the biggest since LSU's 62 in '03, and their winning margin the widest since Texas won by 30 in '98.

Granted, the Ducks haven't been taking indoors seriously for long, but remarkably, their best ever previous finish was 9<sup>th</sup> last year.

Day 1 of the meet did not portend Duck dominance—Zoe Buckman failed to qualify for the 800 final and Nicole Blood, looking tired and hitting the rail a few times, dropped out of the 5000 with less than 800 remaining while in 4<sup>th</sup>.

Meanwhile, Tennessee senior Jackie Areson ran a great race for 3<sup>rd</sup> (15:39.65) behind the dominating victory of Iowa State's Lisa Koll (15:39.65) and Marie

Louise Asselin of West Virginia (15:50.53).

But the Duck machine began to waddle into overachievement mode when sophomore Amber Purvis ran 23.21 for 4<sup>th</sup> behind

Auburn's Shaniqua Ferguson's 23.09 winner.

Texas A&M's title hopes took a big hit, as senior Porscha Lucas, reportedly suffering from a sore back, failed to qualify for the 200m final.

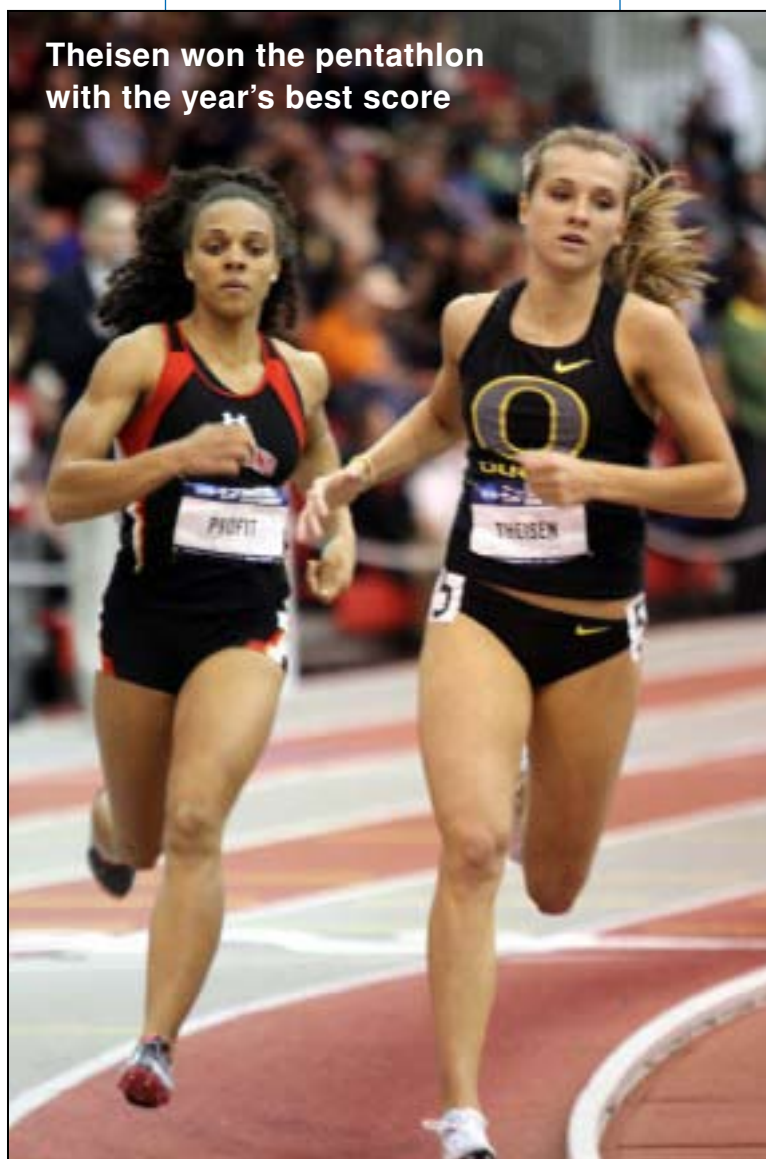
In the distance medley, Friday night's final event, Oregon's star frosh Jordan Hasay started the 1600 anchor quickly, along with Georgetown's Emily Infeld, with a 66-second first 400 to catch Tennessee's Brittany Sheffey, who looked like a sitting duck.

But the Vol soph ran a remarkably smart, controlled race and held off Hasay off the final curve to defend their title 10:58.37–10:58.96.

Saturday morning saw the Ducks receive an expected 10 points from senior Brianne Theisen's comfortable win in the pentathlon. Her 4396 point total put her more than 150 ahead of Kiani Profit of Maryland (4242).

Saturday's first track final, the mile, saw Hasay and German frosh Anne Kesselring coming back from heats and the DMR the night before. While neither was able to challenge Florida's Charlotte Browning for the win (4:35.66), Hasay held on for 4<sup>th</sup> (4:38.29) and Kesselring 6<sup>th</sup> (4:40.39) for an 8-point haul.

As the team title heated up, an individual managed to grab a bit of the spotlight in the women's 400

final. In section 1, Oregon's Keshia Baker took advantage of being in the slower heat, running unimpeded to a collegiate-leading 51.63.

But in section 2, Hampton senior Francena McCorory, went out quickly, hitting the 200 in 23.81, and after a challenge by Texa A&M's Jessica Beard, simply powered away hitting the line in 50.54 to break Diane Dixon's 19-year old American record of 50.64 set in winning the '91 World Indoor.

Meanwhile in the vault, Oregon junior Melissa Gergel was having the competition of her life, eventually clearing 14-7¼ (4.45—13cm better than her previous lifetime best) to place 2<sup>nd</sup> behind the 14-9 (4.50) winner by Indiana State senior Kylie Hutson.

Both Hasay and Blood started the 3000, but it was obvious, after seeing Duck assistant Robert Johnson speaking to Hasay shortly before the start, that the Oregon frosh may not be required to finish. She did not, but Blood did, finishing 5<sup>th</sup> (9:11.23) behind the great duel between Koll and defending outdoor 5000 and cross champ Angela Bizzarri of Illinois. The Illini senior sat patiently before unleashing a kick the final 200m to win 8:57.40-8:57.20.

After Texas A&M only managed to score one point in the triple jump, the team title was secure for the Ducks, but they still managed to cap the meet with a bit of style. Never known as a sprint powerhouse, Oregon took the lead on Baker's impressive 51.12 second leg and held on to win over LSU 3:32.97-3:33.79.

Said Coach Johnson, "We got things started off with a win in the pentathlon, which was huge for us, and it just kept rolling from there, and closed it out with style by winning the relay."
