

— Relay Duty For Felix & Jeter At Mt. SAC —

Walnut, California, April 15–17—With the 2010 season being the in-between year for Americans with no major outdoor championship team to make, many elite athletes are looking at the campaign as one for just getting out to compete and have fun.

Two prime examples of that approach came in the women's 4x1 at the 52nd Mt. SAC Relays when sprint stars Allyson Felix and Carmelita Jeter performed for their baton quartets.

They were '09's No. 1 World Rankers in the 200 and 100,, and turned in solid carries and they literally stretched their legs in early-season racing.

Felix anchored the Bobby Kersee All-Stars to a 43.64 victory, 0.20 ahead of the West Coast All-Stars unit that featured the outdoor-debuting Jeter on the backstretch second leg.

The same threesome that preceded Felix in the team's 43.52 win last week at the Johnson/JJK meet carried the stick to their anchor, Ginnie Powell and Carol Rodriguez switching legs at Mt. SAC.

Nicole Leach handled the second turn as Felix got the baton with a comfortable lead that she carried to the end.

Jeter stormed the backstretch after getting the baton from Lakeisha Lawson; the Worlds outdoor 100 and indoor 60 bronze winner passed to Candice Davis as they appeared to use every millimeter of the exchange zone. Miki Barber ran a strong final 100 in chasing Felix but couldn't reel in the three-time global 200 champ.

Relaxing after the race, Felix said of her approach to the '10 season, "It's going to be kind of a transition year for me. I want to

Jeter said, "[Coach] John Smith and I want to work on perfecting my race this year. So we're going to work on a lot of technical things.

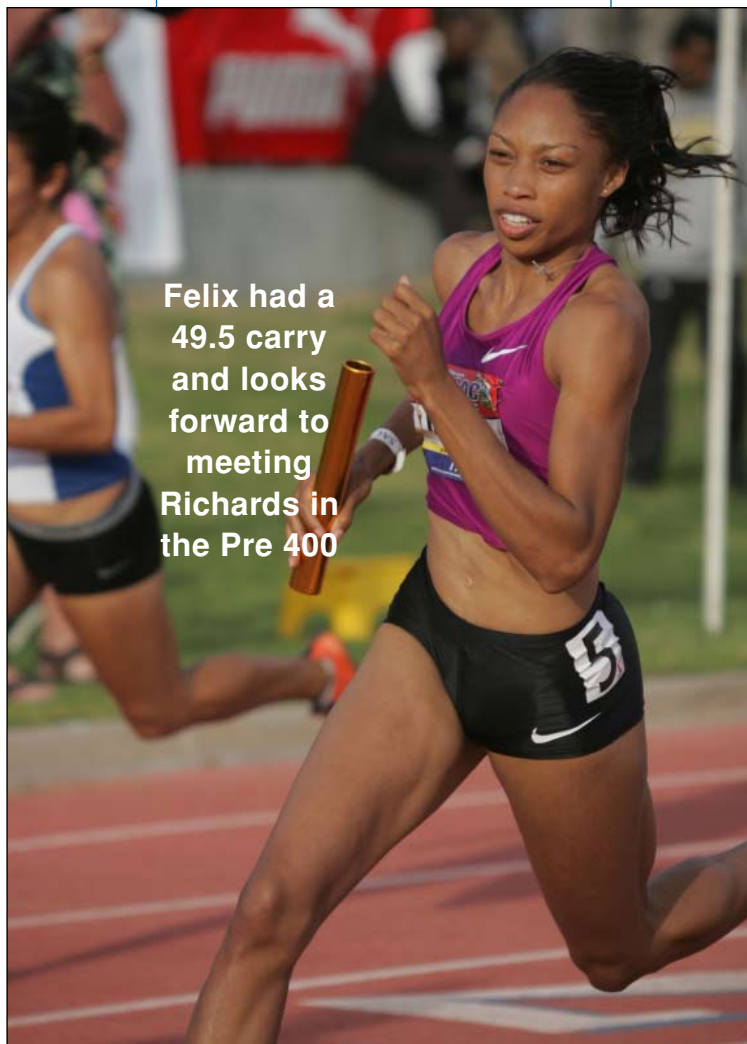
"Also I want to make this a year to have some fun and not have any stress in racing. The championships cycle starts again in '11, so I want to make this year as enjoyable as possible."

A nice pair of one-lappers came from USC soph Joey Hughes. First, he rolled to a sizable lead off the final turn in the flat race and his half-second PR of 45.37 comfortably handled the late charge by Briton Martyn Rooney (45.85).

Then Hughes stormed a 44.8 third leg as the Trojans clocked 3:03.70 to take the 4x4. Bryshon Nellum led off in 46.9, Nate Anderson took 46.5 for his second leg and frosh hurdler Reggie Wyatt finished up in 45.5.

Two women's races highlighted the distances. First a Seattle 1500 duel was won by Washington's Katie Follett, who sprinted past leader Jessica Pixler of Seattle Pacific on the inside with 50 meters left en route to nearly a five-second PR win of 4:10.66.

Pixler slashed more than 6.0 off her former best with her 4:11.06

focus just on performances.

"So I expect to run quite a few 400s this year. It's going to be good to match up with Sanya [Richards], especially here in the U.S. at the Pre Classic."

Felix showed she is already in impressive 1-lap form—even if on a relay carry—as she contributed a 49.5 second leg to the Kersee

At 5000, Sally Kipyego forged the pace from the start, with Molly Huddle in tow. They passed 3K in 9:05.6 before many-time NCAA champ Kipyego pulled ahead to stay as she won in an outdoor PR 15:02.83.

Huddle demolished her previous best by more than 12 seconds as she clocked 15:05.73 behind the Kenyan.

On the field, Funmi Jimoh and Akiba McKinney both long jumped 22-4¼ (6.81) but Jimoh took the win thanks to a longer second-best (21-5¼/6.53 to 21-2/6.45).

And in the women's open hammer, USC frosh Lauren Chambers twice lengthened the American Junior Record, first with a 203-7 (62.05) opener and then a third-round 206-5 (62.93).
