

— Penn Relays: AKA The Usain Bolt Show —

Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, April 20–24—As soon his participation was announced a few weeks before the meet, there was no question what this year's Penn Relays would be: The Usain Bolt Show.

Oh sure, the big contingent of green & gold-clad Jamaican fans were still there to cheer on their usual high school and college teams, but this year, there was... more. More of them—a record 54,310 Saturday attendance—and even more enthusiasm than normal, if that can be believed.

The atmosphere leading up to the race was electric, as anticipation built and national rivalry took hold. When Jamaica's Wolmer's Boys clocked a stunning 39.78 for the 4x1 championship and the Jamaican women easily took the sprint medley in 3:35.37, chants of "Ja-mai-CA!" shook the stadium.

Moments later, after a determined Carmelita Jeter held off Shelly-Ann Fraser in the 4x1 for a U.S. win (42.74 vs. 42.94), the answering chant of "U-S-A" took over. One would have thought it was a dual meet.

And then Bolt, who had snuck onto the crowded infield about half an hour earlier, was finally spotted. "There he is!" shouted a woman near the press table, and the crowd exploded, oblivious to anything else. The starter had to ask for quiet to get the IC4A 4x2 off the line.

Finally, the moment for which the packed stadium waited arrived. The dueling chants started up again, forcing the starter to balk and try again. And then it was happening. No matter your nationality, you had to pray for no dropped batons or pulled muscles to destroy this moment.

Amid a deafening roar—meet director Dave Johnson said he'd never heard it quite so loud—the

Jamaicans deftly handled their passes.

And as so often happens, the American handoffs were less than perfect, especially the second exchange between Mike Rodgers and Shawn Crawford.

When Bolt took the stick in the lead, the script was complete. Bolt's leg was clocked in a physics-defying 8.79, taking his Jamaica Gold teammates

(Mario Forsythe, Yohan Blake, Marvin Anderson) to a 37.90 meet record ahead of USA Blue's 38.33 (Dix, Crawford, Rodgers, Ivory Williams).

"Jamaica Boom!" said the crowd. Indeed, one had to wonder just where this meet was being held: "There's nothing like a home crowd for me," Bolt said after the race. "I love running here."

"We didn't have perfect sticks," Crawford lamented. "I wish we had perfect sticks so we could show what we could do."

And then it was over. The moment, that is. But of course there was still about three hours of track & field to go, and the true track fans stayed around to see some magical moments, such as two U.S. teams almost beating Kenya in the men's DMR, Queen Harrison's 12.61 meet record in the 100H, Texas A&M's men dropping the stick and still almost winning the 4x4, and the soon-to-be canceled Seton Hall program winning its men's and women's 4x4 sections.

And of course there was the baton dominance of the Tennessee women, winning a trio of collegiate events—4x8, 4x15, DMR—for the second year in a row, and two Collegiate Records by the Aggie women, 1:29.42 in the 4x2 and 52.50 in the shuttle hurdles.

But the crowd began thinning after Bolt's race. As the noisy victory lap wound down, the announcer called for calm and said, "We need to start the next race."

Or as someone else once said: "Ladies and gentlemen, Elvis has left the building."
