

— Lagat Sets 5K AR In Oslo DL —

Oslo, Norway, June 4—Billed as a shot at the World Record at the Bislett Games, the third stop on the Diamond League tour, the men's 800, while superb, had to take a back-seat to a heart-pounding 5000 that ended with Bernard Lagat regaining the American Record despite finishing 3rd.

The asked-for pace was 7:45 at 3000 as the 19-runner field got away on a beautiful Scandinavian evening, Lagat and compatriot Chris Solinsky settling in around 5th and 6th in the early going.

Kenyan Eliud Kipchoge and Vincent Chepkok led the main pack behind the rabbits. At 3K in a spot-on 7:45.63, pacer Remmy Ndiwa moved aside and the racing began with Chepkok leading Kipchoge, Tariku Bekele (whose brother Kenenisa was missing due to an ongoing calf injury), Lagat, Solinsky, Ethiopia's Imane Merga and steeple WR holder Saif Shaheen—coming back from his own leg miseries the last two years—also in the mix.

Chepkok continued to set a 10:24.38 tempo past the 4K post with about 10 runners still following within striking distance. With about 600 to go, Lagat moved to his right out of the bunch, looking to get in position for his finishing sprint.

On the first turn after the bell, Bekele led the pack but Lagat audaciously moved inside to challenge for the lead. Around the final turn, Bekele and Lagat pulled ahead with Merga coming up fast.

Heading into the homestretch, Lagat and Bekele duelled side by side, but Merga swung wide into lane 3 and sprinted headlong after them. The 21-year-old closed strongest and collared the leading duo some 30 meters from the finish.

Merga's 12:53.81 cut his PR down from the 12:55.66 he ran last year in Brussels. Bekele was close behind at 12:53.97, while Lagat came home in 12:54.12 to lower the AR from Dathan Ritzenhein's 12:56.27 set last year in Zürich. Lagat closed in 55.1.

Solinsky got within a stride or so of Ritz's mark with a 12:56.66 for 6th that slashed the PR for the Wisconsin grad from his 13:12.24 in '07. He becomes the only American ever to

run a sub-13:00/sub-27:00 combo.

In this race, the first 10 finishers clocked sub-13:00 efforts, with Shaheen 11th at 13:00.31 as placers 8–11 set best-ever marks-for-place.

Lagat Tweeted, "Happy with AR today, but my son isn't. Now I have to explain to him why I didn't win."

And, "Happy for Solinsky too! I hope he will let me keep the record for a little part of the season!"

As for that men's two-lapper, favored David Rudisha took command down the last backstretch, passing 600 in 1:15.05 with Abubaker Kaki in hot pursuit. A two-man homestretch sprint saw Rudisha hold on to win in 1:42.04 from Kaki's 1:42.23.

"I knew that after 600, I still needed to push," said the Kenyan star.

He also revised his time goals for this season: "I'm not thinking about the World Record now, but more about being consistent in the 1:42 range."

Asafa Powell won his second Diamond League 100, his 9.72 aided by a barely-illegal 2.1mps wind. The Jamaican got a strong start and had built an unbeatable lead after just 10 meters to finish well ahead of Olympic silver medalist Richard Thompson (9.90w).

In a notable women's high jump clash, Blanka Vlašić and Chaunté Lowe

both were clean through four heights to 6-7 (2.01). But the world champ topped 6-7 initially while the American need two tries and that proved the difference as Vlašić avenged her Ostrava 3rd behind Lowe on May 27.
