

### — NCAA Women: A&M Defends Here Too —

Eugene, Oregon, June 9–12—After the third day of the 29<sup>th</sup> edition of the NCAA Women's Championships, host Oregon led the team scoring with 30 points.

Tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> at 26, defender Texas A&M figured to pull in final-day points in the speed events.

And so the Aggies did. After retaining their 4 x 100 title by nearly a second with a 42.82 effort (with a patchwork lineup), suddenly the two powerhouses were tied for the lead at 36.

Oregon got 6 more from the 3<sup>rd</sup> by frosh Jordan Hasay in the 1500 to make it 42–36 after 17 events. Then came the 200, where A&M fielded defending champ Porscha Lucas, plus 4x1 lead-off Jeneba Tarmoh—the duo that had also placed 2–3 in the 100—plus unexpected finalist Dominique Duncan.

So the Aggies proceeded to grab a huge 22 points thanks to a Lucas-Tarmoh 1–2, with Duncan coming up big in 5<sup>th</sup> to chip in 4 points. In the space of about 23 seconds, A&M slammed the door on everyone else's hopes.

Pat Henry's troops stood at 58, which would have been just enough to edge Oregon at the end, as the Ducks scored a final tally of 57. But A&M got more points from the 6<sup>th</sup>-places of Vashti Thomas (100H) and Hillary Pustka (JT).

And in a fitting close

to the meet, Oregon and A&M battled down to literally the final stride of the 4x4 before UO's Keisha Baker just prevailed ahead of A&M's Jessica Beard by 0.03 in 3:28.54.

But A&M's final total of 72 kept the champion's trophy in College Station and

gave the Aggies a second consecutive sweep of both the men's and women's titles.

"Everybody knew it was about the team," said Henry afterward, clutching individual plaques for both wins. "That's what we talked about all year long, so this wasn't an exception. It's about responding to ups and downs."

And A&M came to Eugene after two major downs: injuries to hurdlers Gabby Mayo (also a key leg on the 4x1) and Natasha Ruddock. Both were injured at Regionals, Mayo with a strained left quad and Ruddock with a torn ACL.

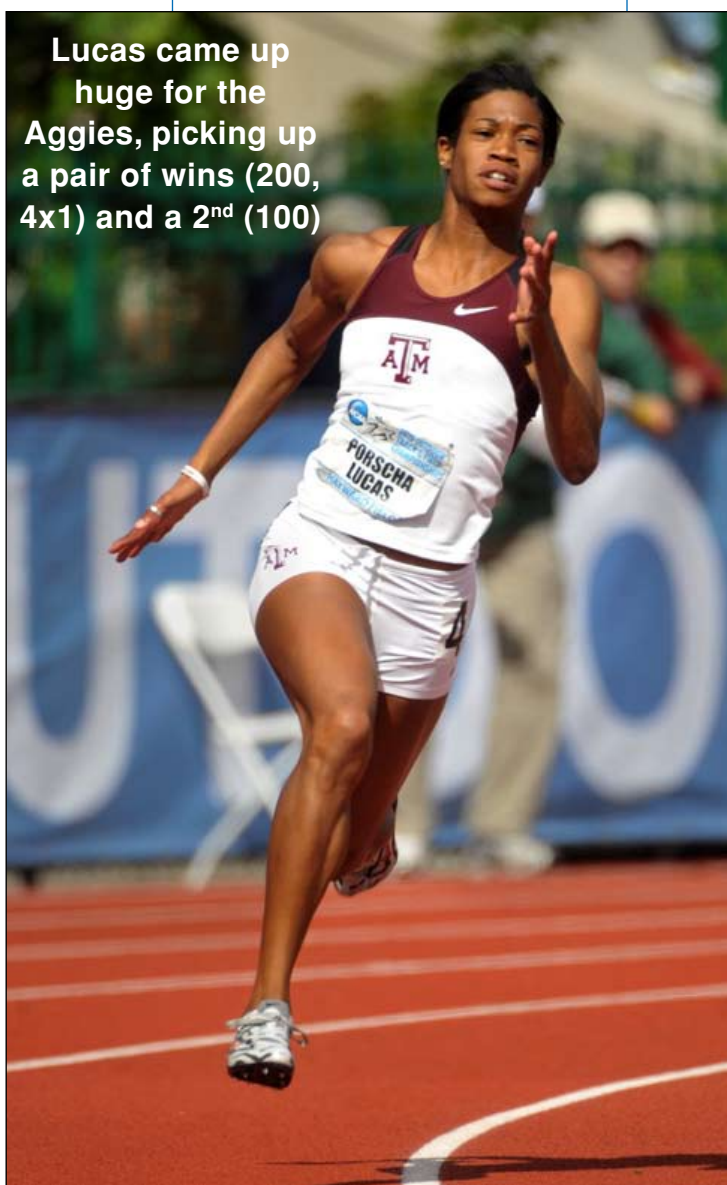
Henry added, "We talked about that, too, and that some people weren't 'supposed' to score. So that meant someone had to step up, and they did."

The 200 was huge, of course. Henry said, "Having Dominique Duncan score in the final was really big because it showed others, 'Yeah, we can do it,' because I don't think Dominique was picked to score at all. And then Vashti came up big in the hurdles."

Henry added, "Last night, we talked about what we needed to do today. I put on a blackboard where we were, where other teams were and what we had to do to win. So they knew coming into Saturday what it was all about."

Three double winners made history. UTEP's Blessing Okagbare became the first to win both the 100 (10.98w) and long jump (22-3½/6.79), dominating in each.

Virginia Tech's Queen Harrison became the first to win both hurdles (12.67/54.55) and Iowa State's Lisa Koll ran away with the 5K (15:23.80) and 10K (32:49.35), becoming only the third 5/10 doubler.

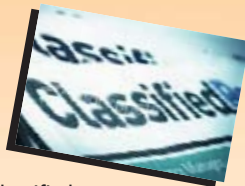
